I have examined the seven postage stamps of Argentina, 1910, "Centenary" issue, all with inverted centers: $\frac{1}{2}$ c., 1c., 2c., 4c., 5c., 12c., 50c. (Scott's Catalogue, Nos. 160a, 161a, 162a, 164a, 167a, 171a, 173a), unused, with gum, a photographic reproduction of which is attached to this certificate. In my opinion, the seven stamps are genuine, they have original gum and they are in perfect condition: I initialled them "ED". They make up the complete set of inverted centers of this issue, and they are especially scarce because of their perfect condition: all such errors were recovered from the printers' waste, and the majority of the copies is crumpled. - - - - -
