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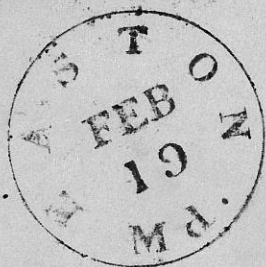
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Provo Aug^t 26th 1860

My Dear John

I fully expected to hear from you by last mail. I send this by Louises Mail who wishes to fetch his gun to protect him from the Bears in Provo Valley. We are thank God all well and expect to come, (that is myself with Mother Moroni & the Baby) to the City shortly, to get our endowments. We gave in our Name last week and all the names of the people of this Place who will get their endowments will be sent to the City in the beginning of this week and then we shall hear what day we shall all have to come in both Mother and myself wish very much if you possibly can, to get somebody that will lend us for the Occasion the necessary Temple Cloth. Mother says that if you would speak with old Greary she would care for the Garments for herself as for myself I think you will be able to procure them.

Can we stay at your Butchlers Hall for the time we are in the City? As I do not know when the time will be that we will be notified to come in, perhaps it would be best for you to come and visit us immediately or otherwise defer it until we come in and then come out with us which latter perhaps would be best you could then go up with me to the Valley & see our new home which I think will please you. Please hurry on Louis that he comes back again as we have to make use of house ready to move in this fall.

Our Sugar Cane Crop looks promising. The quellers I hope the thips will let along until you come though they have visited them already. Cap.
