Enclosed is the pair of R28c revenue stamps used August 24, 1863 on part of a document with the embossed seal of "The Eclectic Medical Society of the Southern Tier of the State of New York".

It was fun researching the history of this society for you. I had never heard of such a society, and I was just as puzzled by this item as you were. I found a reference to "Eclectic Medicine" on Wikipedia's on-line encyclopedia. Apparently, it was a popular branch of American medicine in the late 1800's which emphasized the use of herbal remedies. This branch of medicine developed into what we now refer to as "naturopathic" or "homeopathic" medicine.

If you're curious, the minutes of the 1875 annual meeting of the New York State Eclectic Medical Society are available on-line. The Southern Tier refers to the geographic region of counties west of the Catskill mountains, along the border of Pennsylvania. The specialty of Eclectic Medicine was nationwide, and operated its own separate medical schools. Their annual minutes are amusing to read (they refer to the AMA as "conspirators" and criticize the "establishment" of traditional medicine). Actually, in the 1860's, practitioners of traditional medicine didn't have anything better to offer their patients than the herbal remedies like those advocated by Eclectic medicine. Recall that these were the days before antibiotics, anesthesia, X-rays, or even knowledge of basic germ theory and the importance of sanitation!

Hope this information is helpful.
