National doubled images



Regular issue 6¢ National on left and the major double transfer is at right.
The double transfer covers the entire stamp with a shift of .375 mm down.

6¢ National (no grill) with double impression paid treaty rate to England, Stonington, CT, Feb. 15, 1871. The difference between the two impressions is 1.1 mm upwards.

Margin Arrows at Top and Bottom showed where to cut sheets of 200 into panes of 100.



Plate numbers and partial imprints sometimes appear on vertically misperforated stamps at top or bottom.
