ed with our hands and sealed this 3 day of December 1863
The condition of the above bond is such, that whereas the said Levi
Welty has been appointed School Trustee
for said District No. 3 in said Township No. 18 in said County, and
also elected President of the Board of Trustees of said District, and as such may re-
ceive money for the use of said district. Now, if the said Levi
Welty shall pay over according to law all School moneys that may
come into his hands, faithfully discharge the duties of his said office, and deliver to
his successor all moneys, books and papers in his hands appertaining to his office,
then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to be in full force.

ceive money for the use of said district. Now, if the said Henry Emde
shall pay over according to law all School moneys that may
come into his hands, faithfully discharge the duties of his said office, and deliver to
his successor all moneys, books and papers in his hands appertaining to his office,
then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to be in full force.
