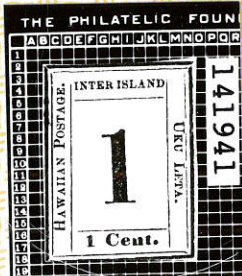
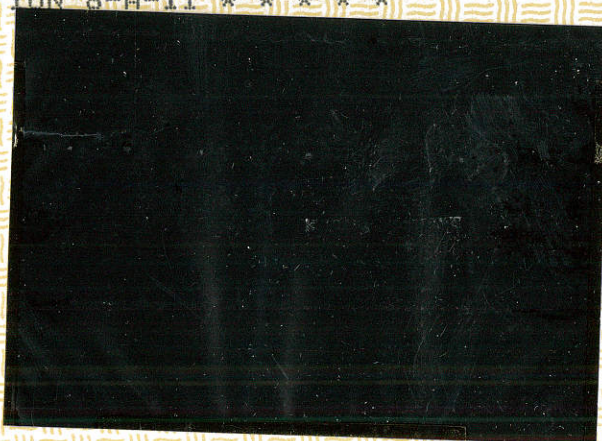

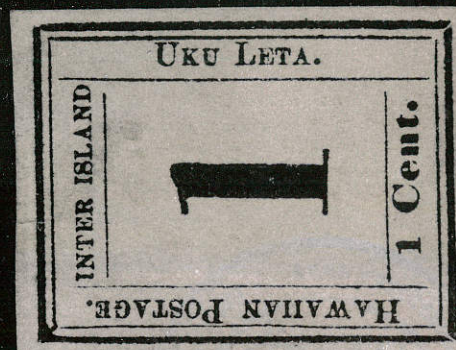

Requests for the plate position of a stamp or overprint will not be accepted. Stamps without gum and used varieties must be thoroughly cleaned of all hinges.

6. Requests for the market or net value of an item will not be accepted. Catalogue values may be furnished if published and desired.

7. The decisions rendered by The American Philatelic Expertization Service are not guaranteed and are only opinions.

8. Since the meanings of the terms, superb, very fine, etc., are debatable, no opinion as to general condition will be given. Defects and alterations not readily apparent will be noted.

9. All reasonable care will be taken of items submitted for examination, but all items are accepted with the full understanding on the part of the owner that neither the American Philatelic Society, the American Stamp Dealers' Association, nor members of their Expertization Committees are liable for any loss or damage resulting from any cause whatever except for gross or willful negligence.

10. Item will be returned as soon after examination as possible but since they are forwarded to committee members not more than once or twice a month, owners should allow between 45 and 60 days before expecting a reply.

11. The American Philatelic Society and the American Stamp Dealers' Association reserve the right to make such changes without notice to the rules and requirements as they deem necessary, but such changes will be announced as soon as possible.

12. The request for an examination constitutes an acceptance by the owner of all rules and requirements of The American Philatelic Expertization Service.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Each stamp or cover submitted for examination must be mounted or affixed to a separate form. A coil pair or block shall be considered a single item. Sets of stamps will not be accepted unless individually mounted on separate forms.

2. Each item must be the bona fide property of the individual submitting it for examination. The owner may assign an identification number to each item submitted.

3. The fee for a certificate of opinion, in accordance with the following schedule, must accompany each item submitted.

<i>Current Scott Catalogue Value</i>	<i>APS/ASDA Members</i>	<i>Non- Members</i>
\$500 or less	\$3.00	\$5.00
Over \$500	\$5.00	\$8.00

Stamps will not be accepted. Foreign checks, including Canadian, will not be accepted unless drawn upon a United States bank and payable in U. S. dollars at par.

4. One stamped self-addressed No. 10 (large 9½") envelope must accompany each item submitted plus one small stamped self-addressed envelope for each item or group of items submitted at one time. The small envelope will be used to acknowledge receipt by returning Owner's Receipt of the Expertization Service form after a number has been assigned. The second envelope (No. 10) will be used to return the item submitted with the report of the opinion rendered. No insurance against loss in the mails will be

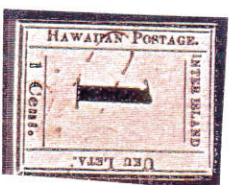
