PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT - USE OF UNOVERPRINTED STAMPS



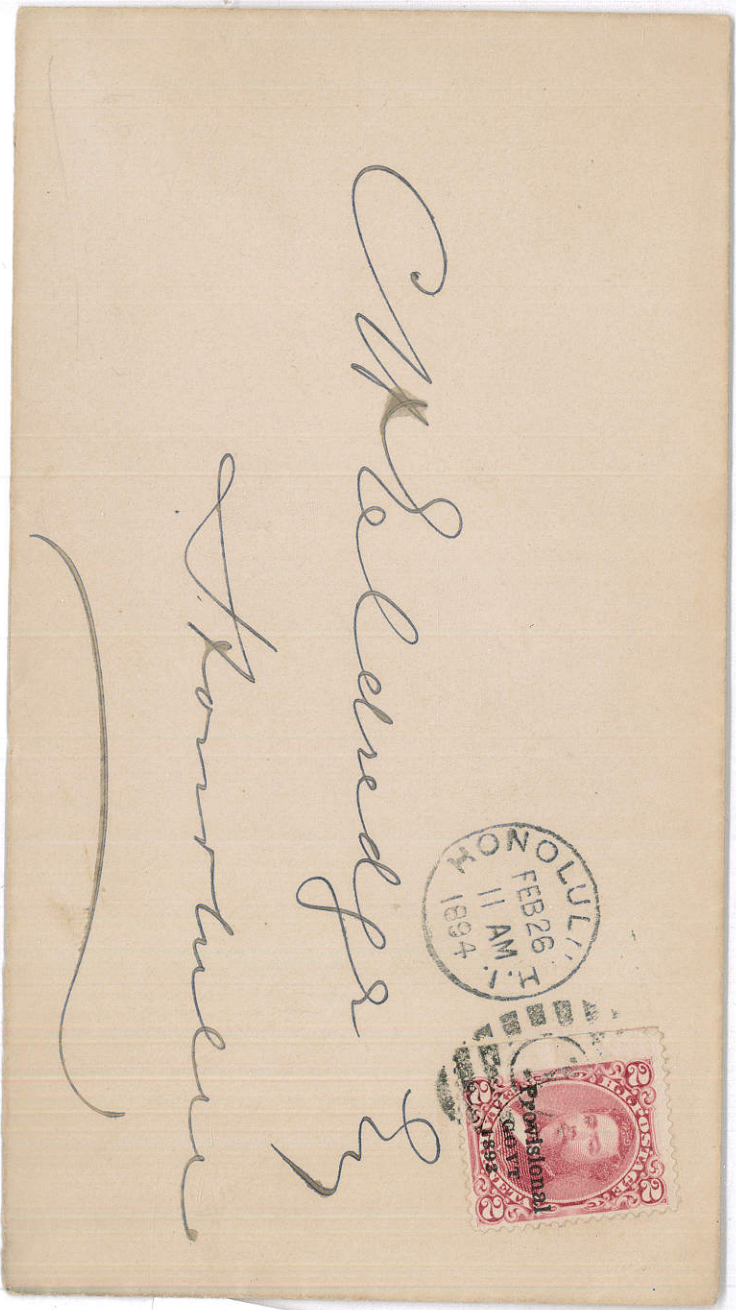
Queen Liliuokalani was deposed on Jan. 17, 1893. Postmaster Oat issued an Order in April 1893 that after May 20, the un-overprinted stamps would not be valid. The fiat was ignored as seen in this example where on September 13, 1893, a registered letter was accepted with "invalid" stamps and an overprint 2 cent probably added to make up needed postage.

The Exhibitor's Grandfather worked at Hart & Company in 1893.

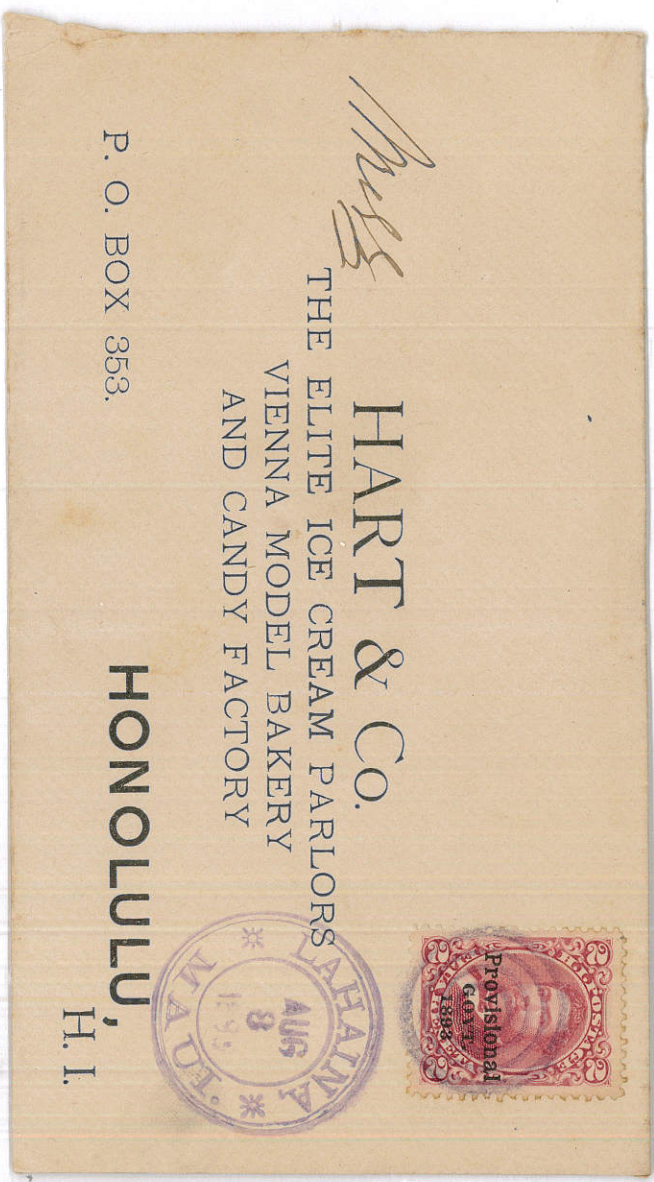

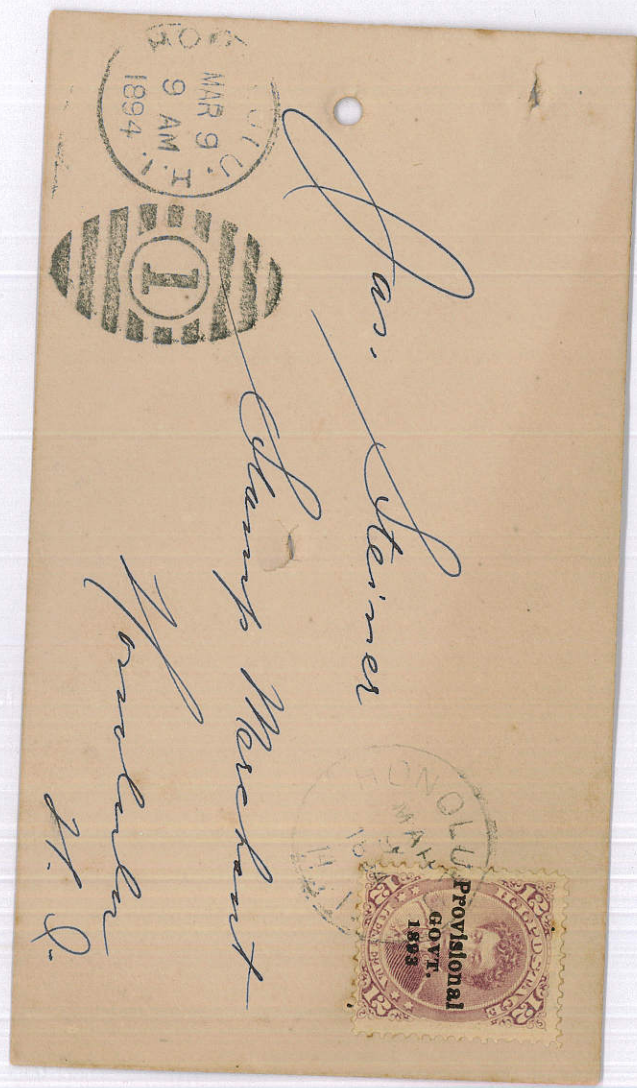
