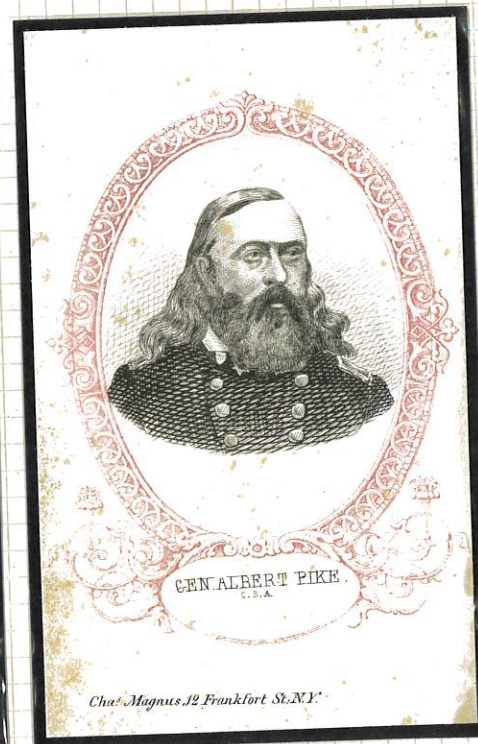
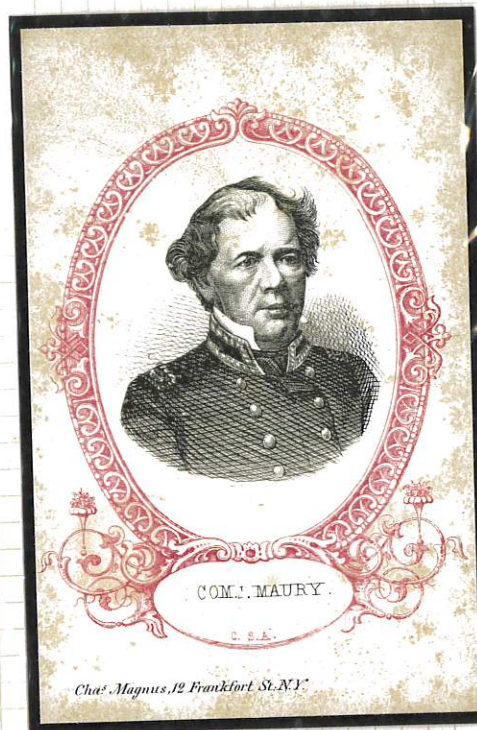
Autograph of Major General Fitzhugh Lee  
Fitzhugh Lee - (Born 1835 - Died 1905) Born in Clermont, Va., and  
educated at West Point. He served the Confederacy during the Civil  
War, and attained the rank of Major General - Commanding  
7th Corps. He served as Governor of Virginia, 1886-1890.  
During the Spanish American War he became a Major General,  
and later became the military governor in Havana, Cuba.

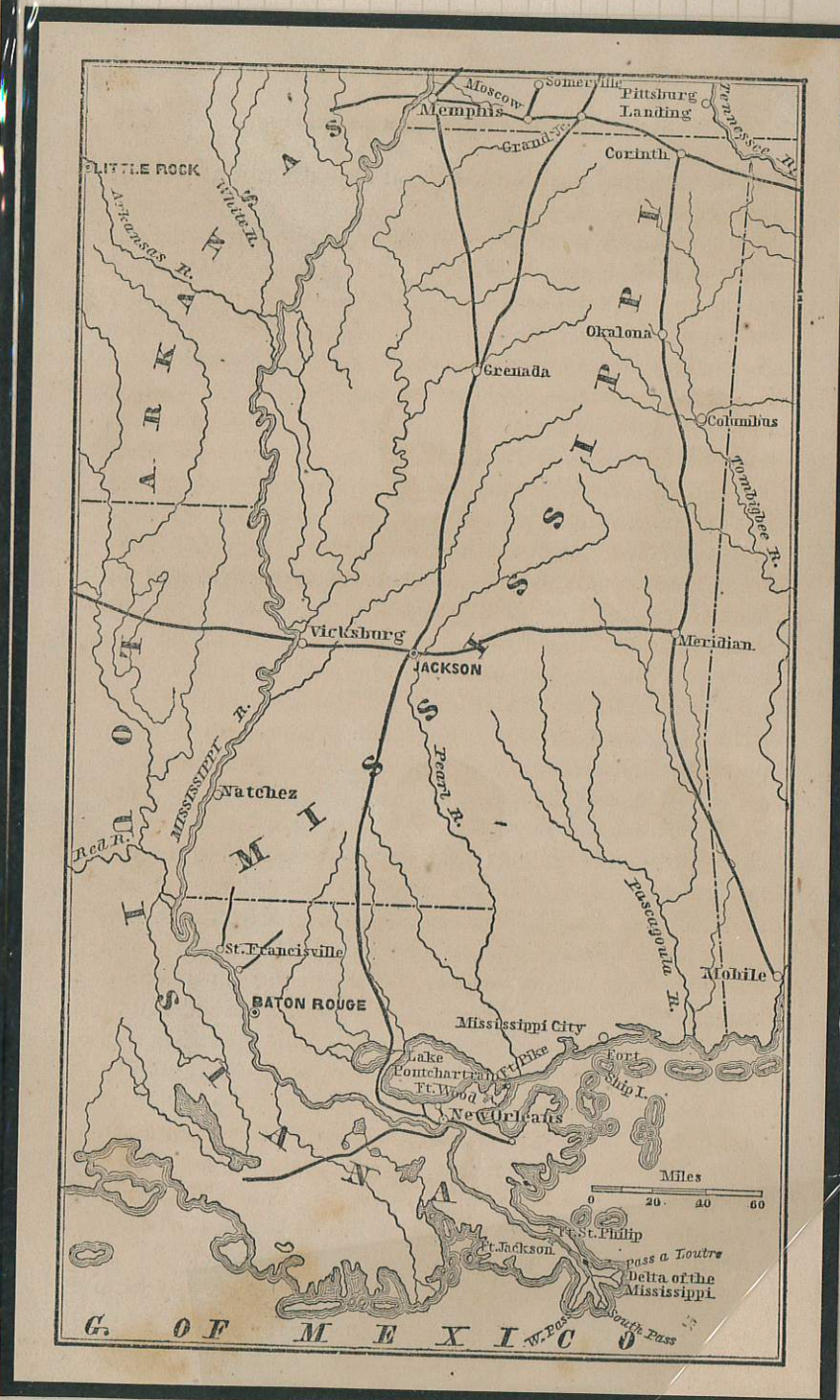
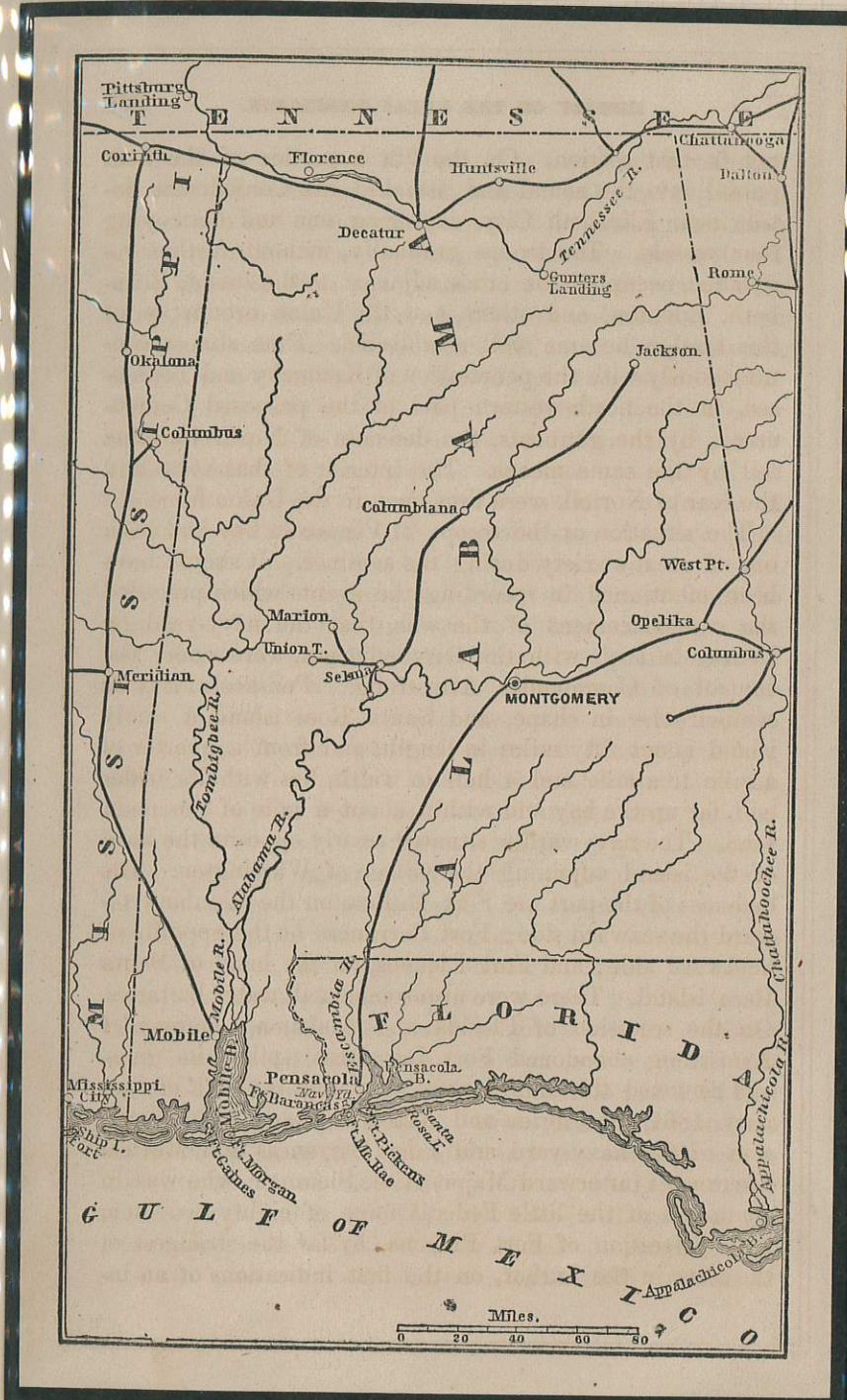


WHITE HOUSE OF THE CONFEDERACY, RICHMOND, VA.

White House of the Confederacy, Richmond, Virginia.  
A name given to it by reason of the fact that it was the  
residence of Jefferson Davis, President of the Confederacy,  
during the Civil War. It is now the Confederate Museum, and  
the shaft of the famous ironclad, "The Merrimac," is shown
