Go-chong

Labor Contract.



This Agreement, made and entered into this 1st day of Dec A. D. 1878 by and between P. C. Davis (act)

on the Island of Hawaii in the Kingdom of the Hawaiian Islands by their agents, WILLIAMS, BLANCHARD & CO. or C. KOOPMANSCHAP, party of the first part, and Go Chong party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

I. The said party of the second part promises to perform such labor for the party of the first part on the Island of Hawaii as the said party of the first part shall direct, and that he will faithfully and punctually perform the same as becomes a good workman, and that he will obey all lawful commands of the said party of the first part, his agent or overseers, during the terms of twelve months, each month to consist of twenty-six working days of ten hours each, work actually performed.

II. The said party of the first part will well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said party of the second part, at the end of each month during which this contract shall remain in force, wages at the rate of twelve dollars for each month, payable in gold or silver coin of the United States, and to provide him also with good and sufficient food and lodging; water and fuel free of charge, the food to consist of rice, beef or pork, or fish, tea, etc., etc., also in case of sickness will receive doctor, medicines, provisions and lodgings free of charge.

III. The said party of the second part agrees to work at night and rest during the day, if directed to do so by the said party of the first part, but to receive extra or additional payment of twelve and one-half cents per hour for all labor performed in excess of the said ten hours per day and the said laborer not to be compelled to work on Sundays.

IV. The said party of the first part agrees to give said party of the second part free transportation and provisions from San Francisco to Honolulu, or to place of destination.


V. The said party of the second part hereby acknowledges the receipt of twenty-four dollars as advanced on the within contract.

Done in duplicate, at San Francisco, the day first above written, that each party may have a copy.




