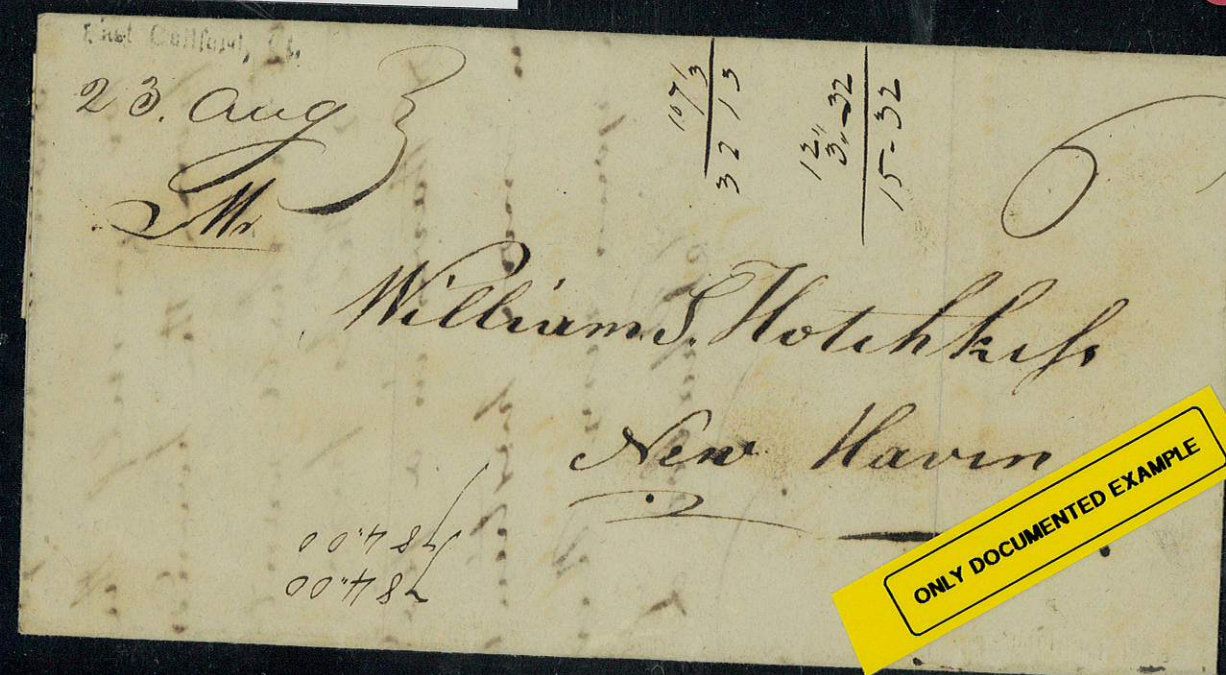
EAST GOSHEN CONN. (L) 50x3mm

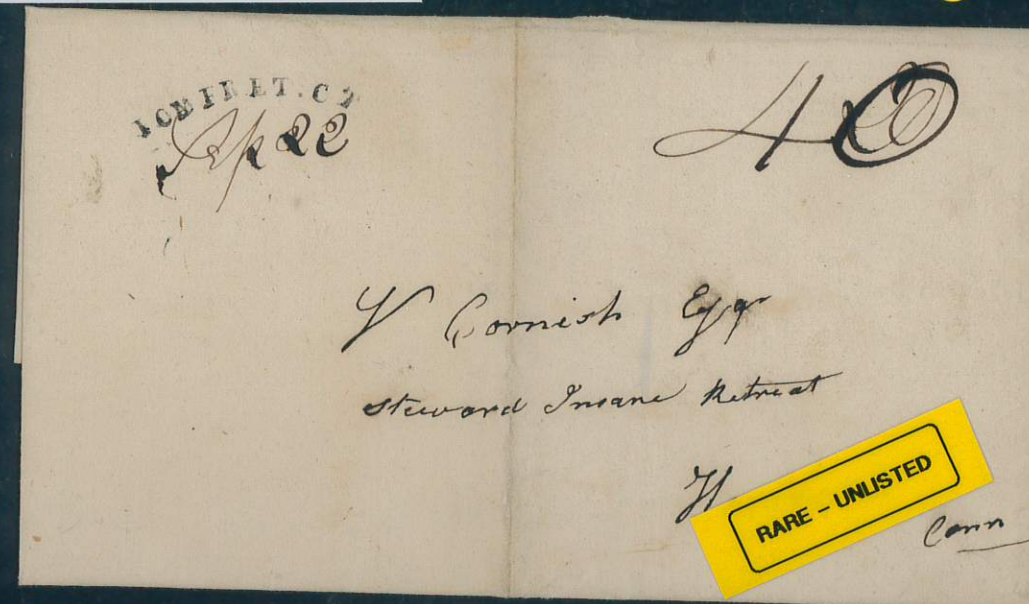
