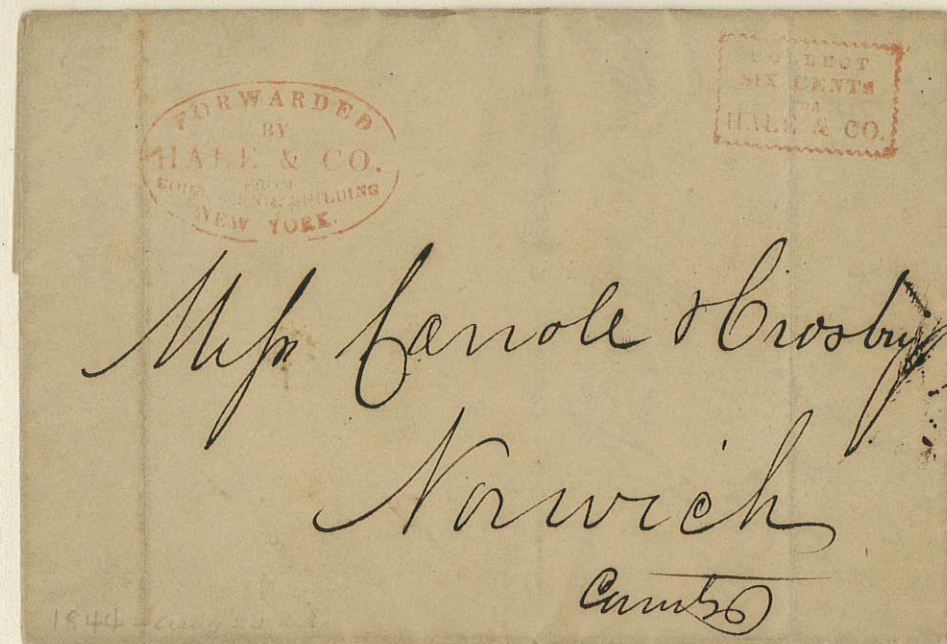


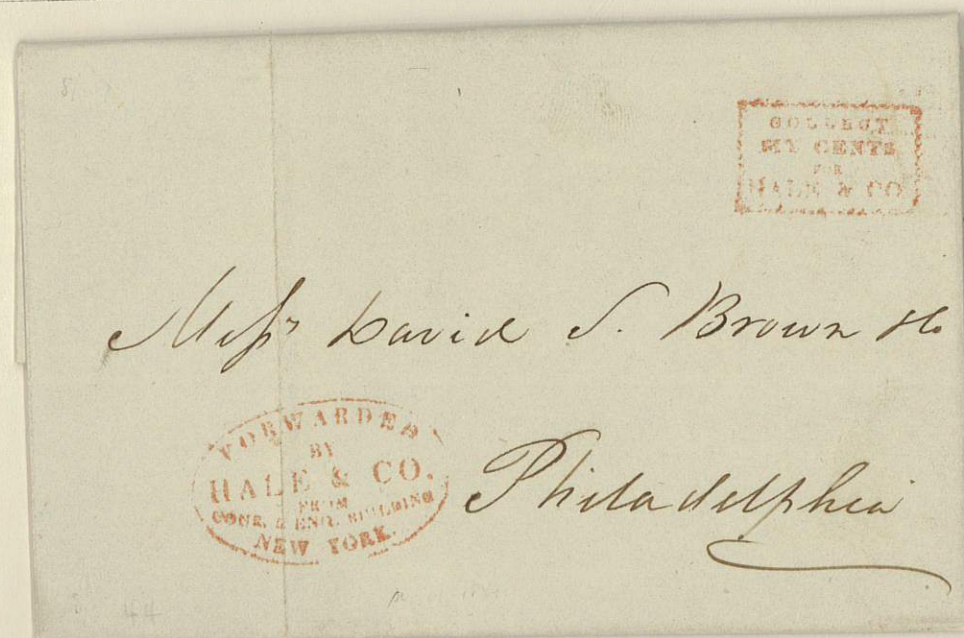

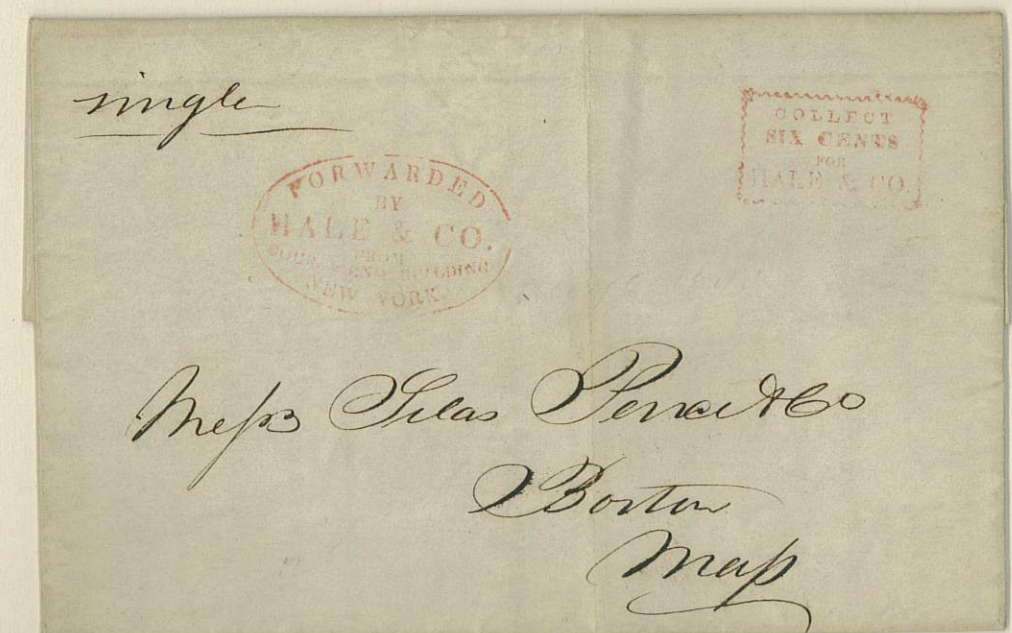
New York City, New York to Hartford, Connecticut dated August 6, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red. It also bears a manuscript "6" notation.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated August 21, 1844. This letter bears a red F-28 forwarding handstamp and a red C2 collect handstamp.



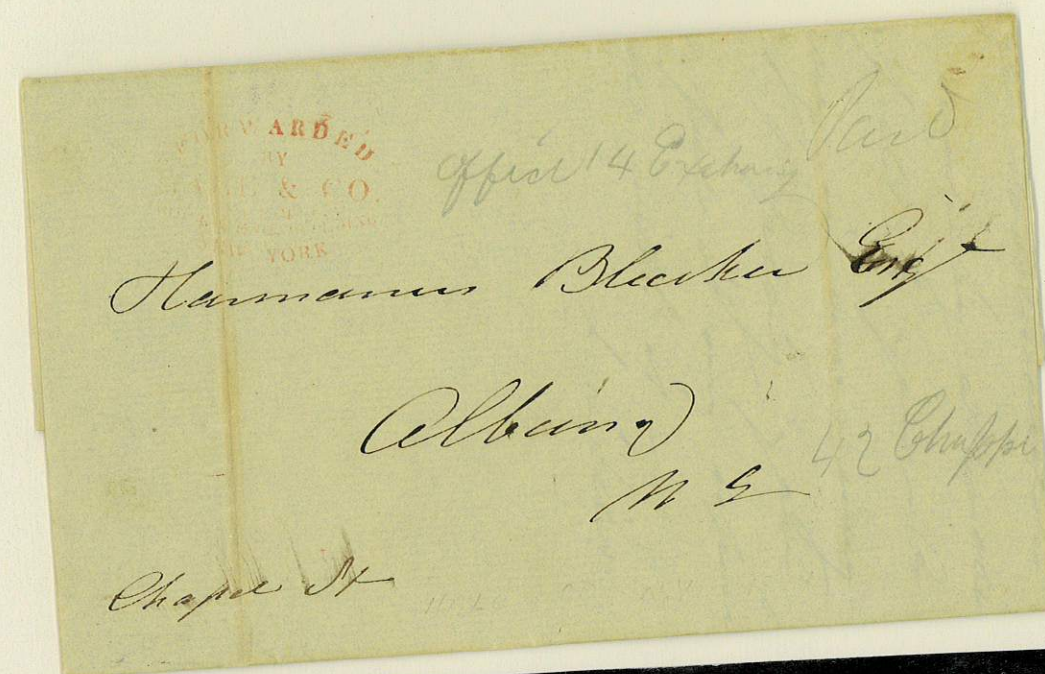

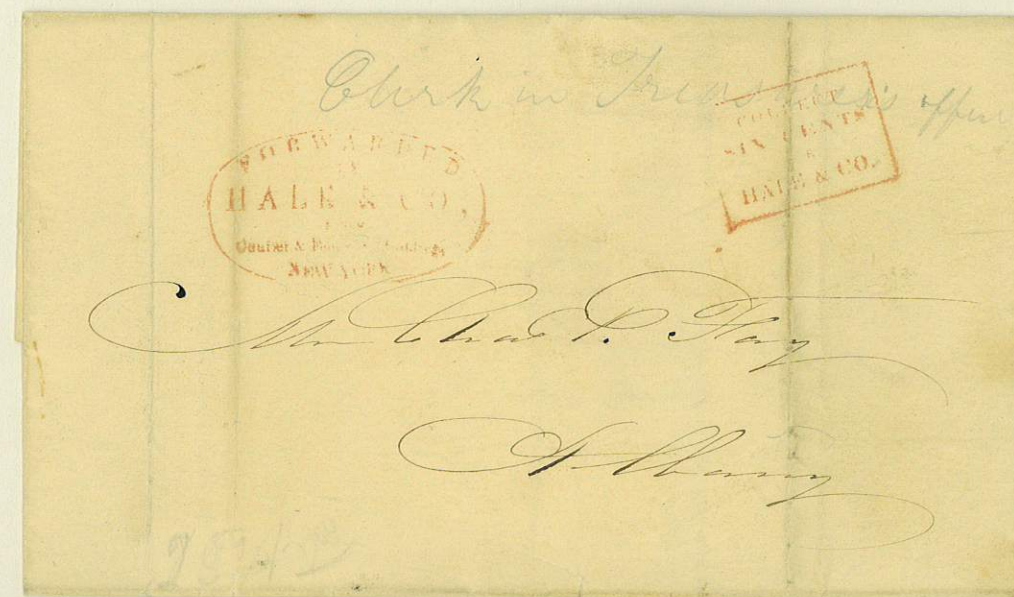
New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated August 12, 1844. This letter bears a red F-28 forwarding handstamp. It also bears several manuscript notations, "Chapel St", "Paid", "Office 14 Exchange" and "42 ???".



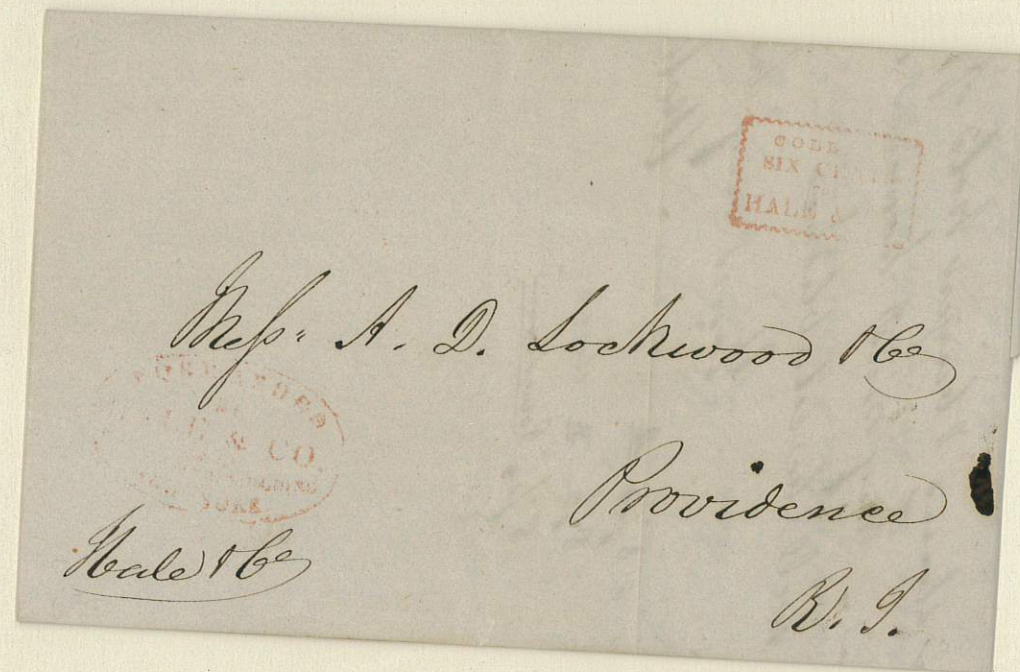
New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated August 23, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp. Also present is a manuscript notation "Re Aug 25/44" that is probably a receiving date.



New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated July 9, 1844. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. Also present is a manuscript notation "Clerk in Treasurers office". These two handstamps were the most used in the New York office with between one hundred and two hundred of each known. This letter is the earliest known Hale letter with an Albany destination.



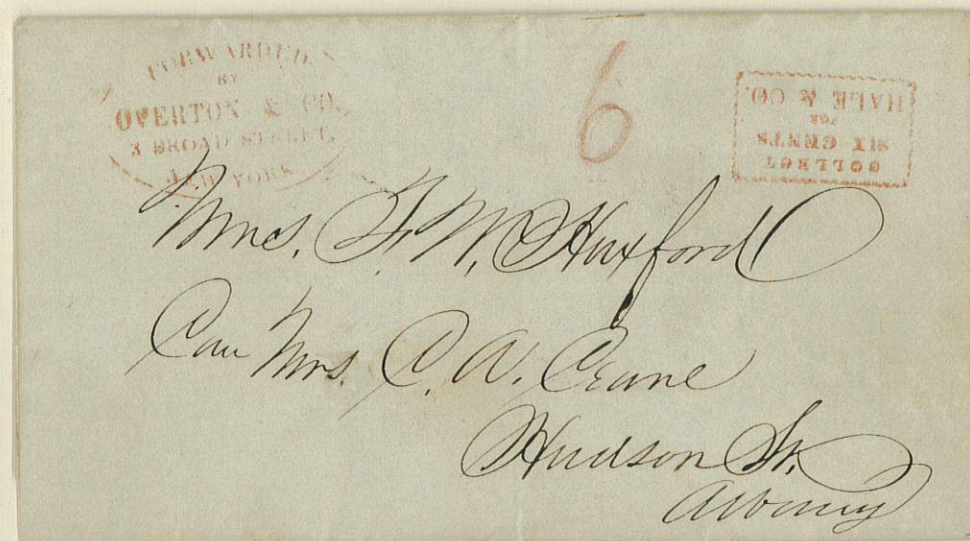
New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated August 27, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red. Also present is the manuscript notation "Hale & co".



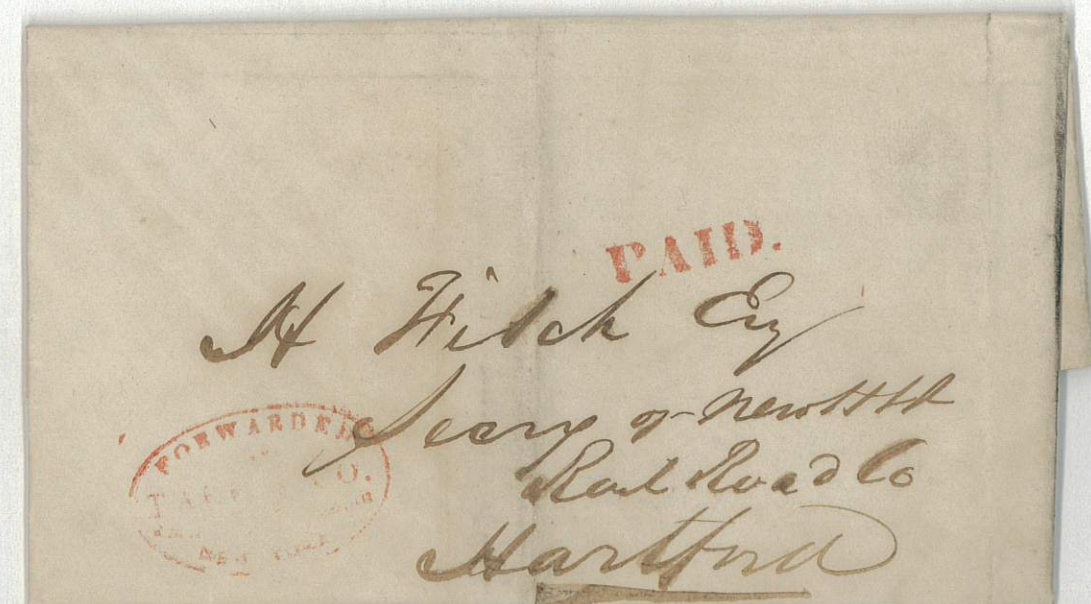
New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated September 1, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red.



New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated August 28, 1844. This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp and an Overton forwarding handstamp in red. Also present is a manuscript "6". Overton ran a mail service from New York City to Albany and perhaps carried some of Hale's mail between these two cities. So few Overton/Hale conjunctive use covers are known that it not clear what the relationship was.



New York City, New York to Hartford, Connecticut dated September 2, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a P-8 paid handstamp, both in red. This is the earliest known use of the P-8 handstamp.



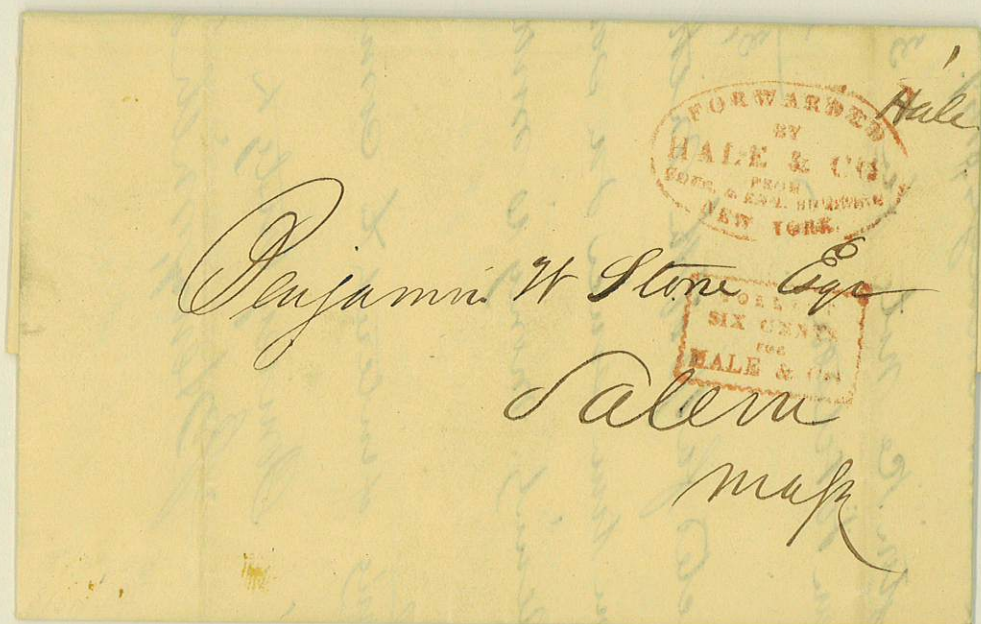
New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated August 17, 1844. It bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red. Also present are two manuscript notations "Single" and "Charged 8th???".



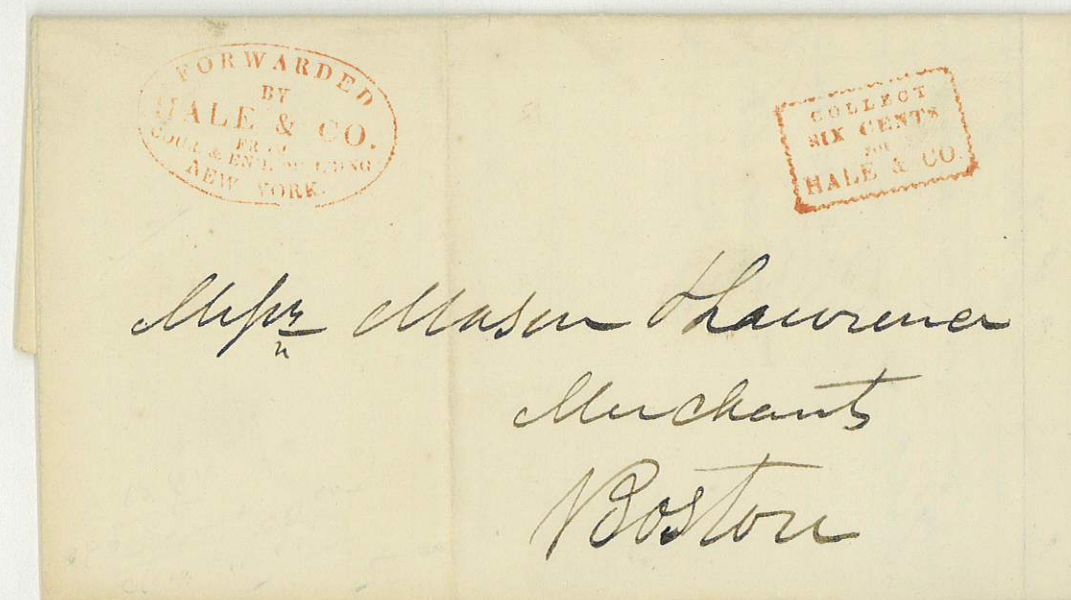
New York City, New York to Worcester, Massachusetts dated September 4, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red.



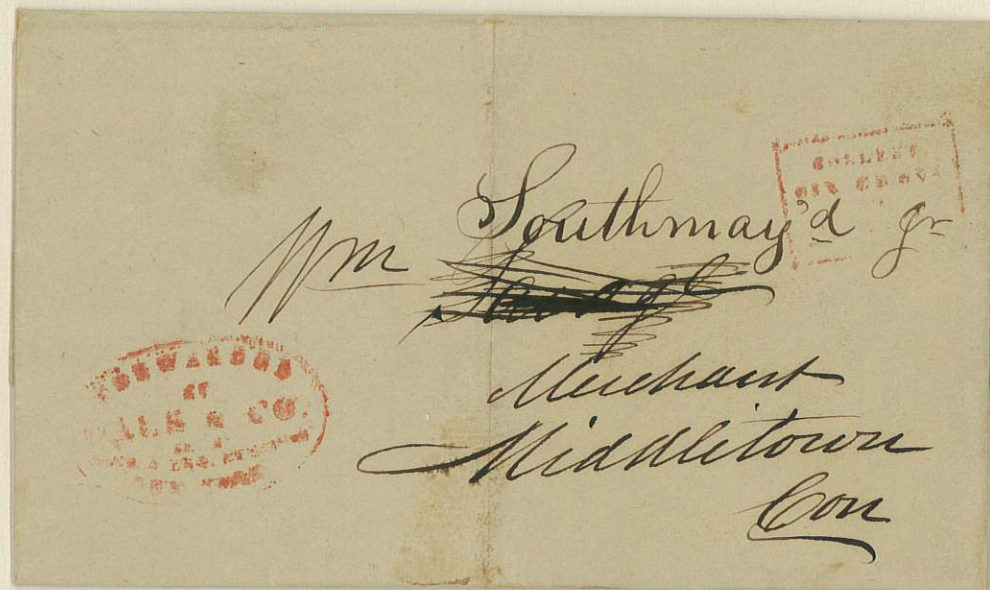

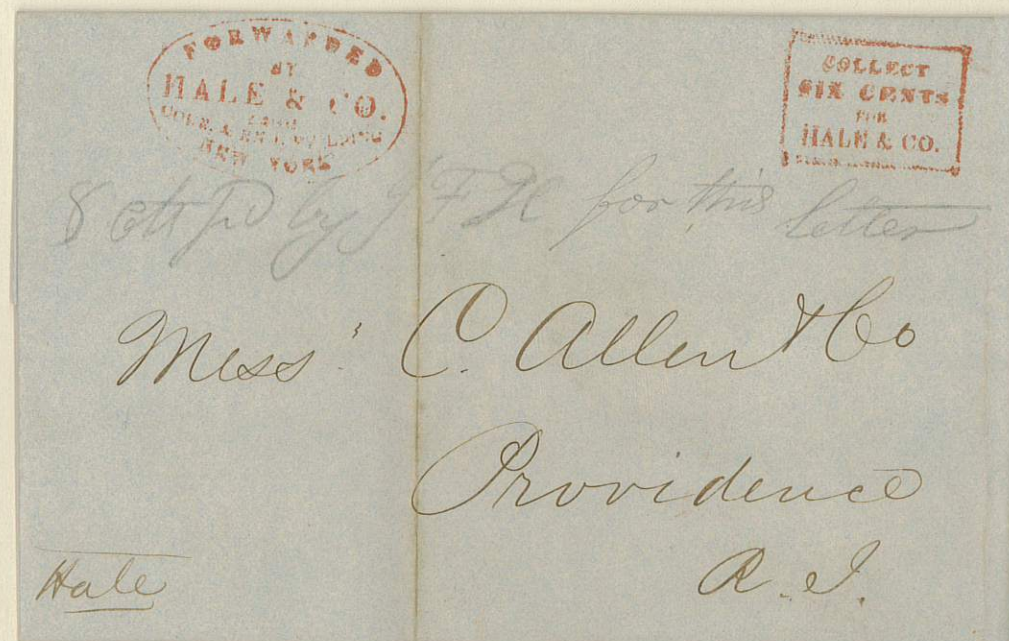

New York City to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated September 6, 1844. It bears a red F-28 forwarding handstamp and a red C-2 collect handstamp.



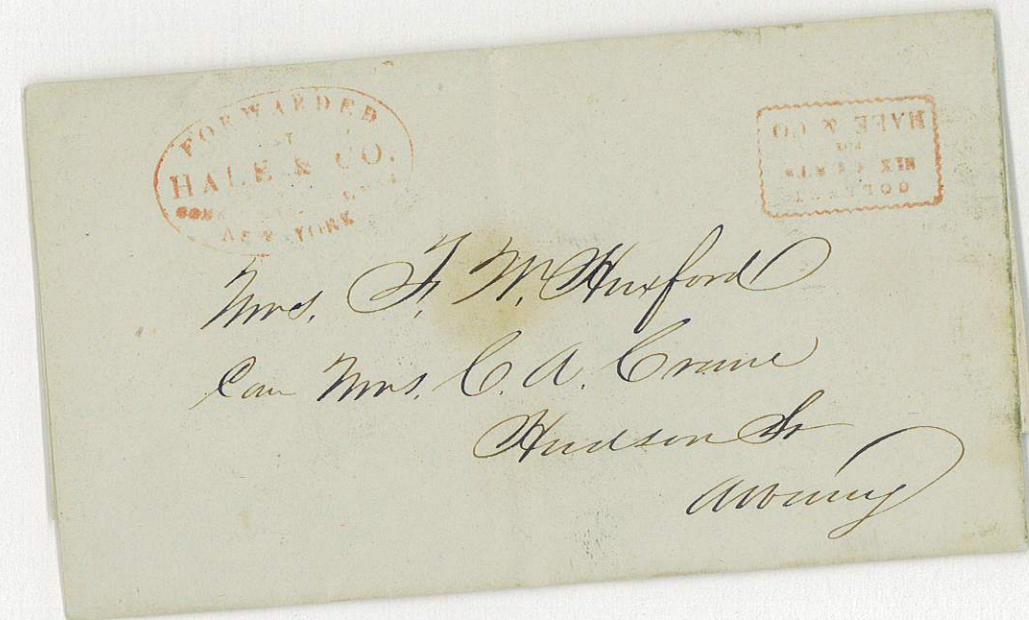

There are two manuscript notations, "Hale" and "8 cts paid by FH for this letter". "FH" is neither the addressee nor the letter writer.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated September 14, 1844. This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp and a manuscript "Single" notation.



New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated September 11, 1844.
This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-2 collect handstamp, both in red.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated September 17, 1844.
This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp.

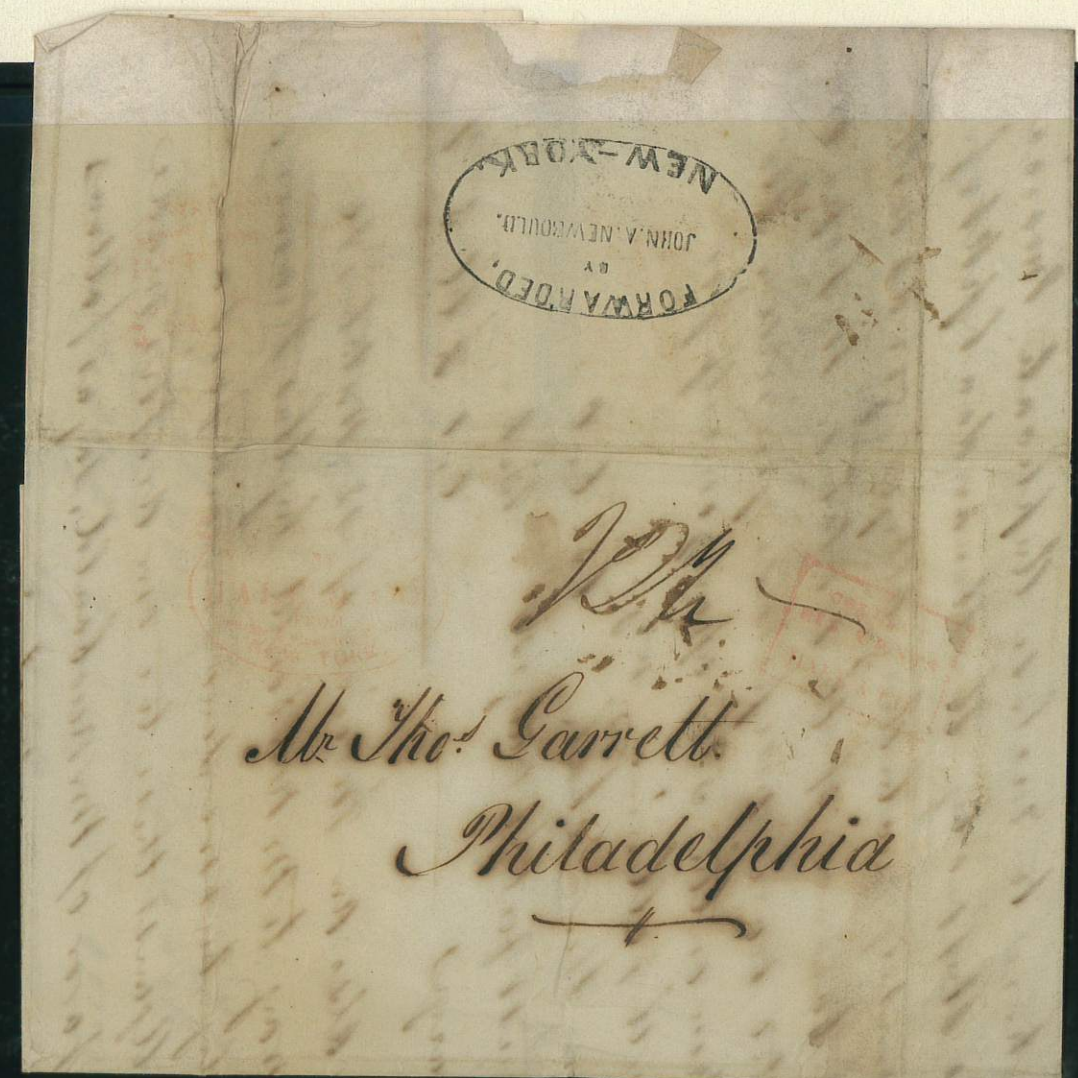

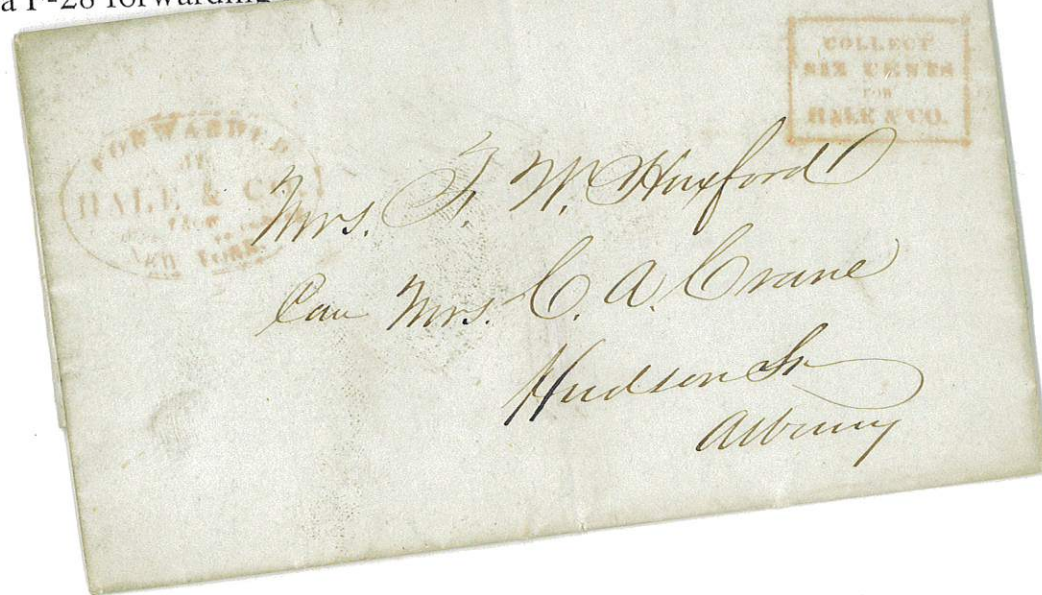


Birmingham, England via New York City, New York to Philadelphia dated September 16, 1844. This letter was probably carried privately from England to New York where it was handed to the forwarder John A. Newbould. Newbould then turned it over to Hale for delivery to Philadelphia. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. There is a manuscript notation that appears to be "12 1/2".

New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated September 30, 1844. This letter bears a red F-28 forwarding handstamp and a red C-3 collect handstamp. This letter is a turned letter, with the original dated September 28, 1844 from Salem, Massachusetts to New York City with a red Salem CDS.



New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated October 2, 1844. This letter bears a F-28 forwarding handstamp in red.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated October 2, 1844. This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp. There are two manuscript notations, "12 1/2" and "Double only" indicating the letter was double weight.



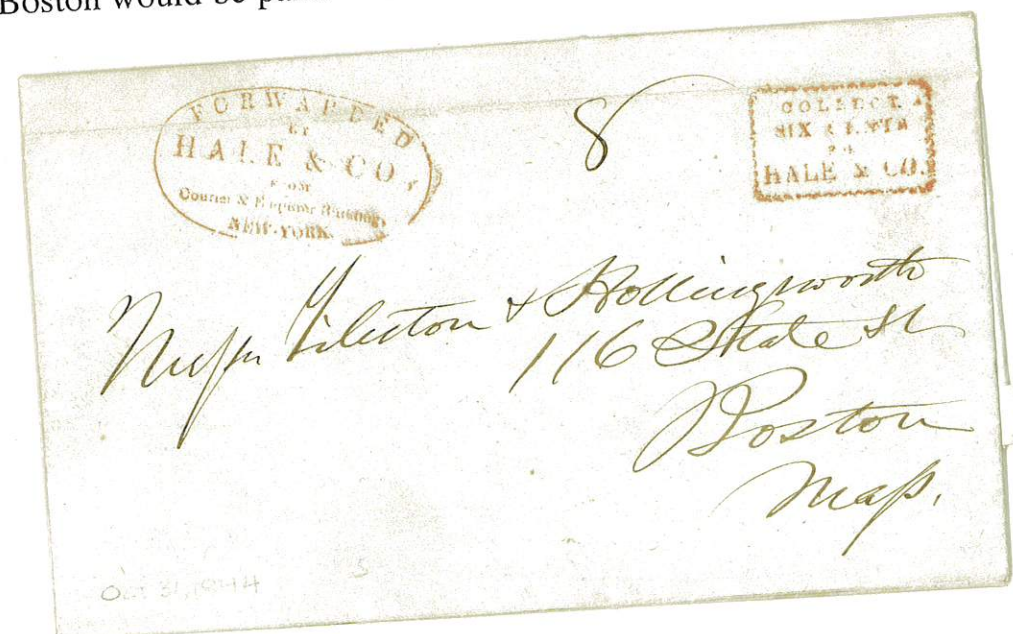
New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated 10/29/44. It bears a red New York F-29 forwarding handstamp and two red C-2 collect handstamps. Two collect handstamps often indicated double weight but there is no indication of an enclosure.



New York City, New York to Hartford, Connecticut dated October 17, 1844. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated October ³¹/₃, 1844. This letter bears a red F-29 forwarding handstamp and a red C-3 collect handstamp. Also present is the manuscript notation "8" indicating local delivery in Boston would be paid.



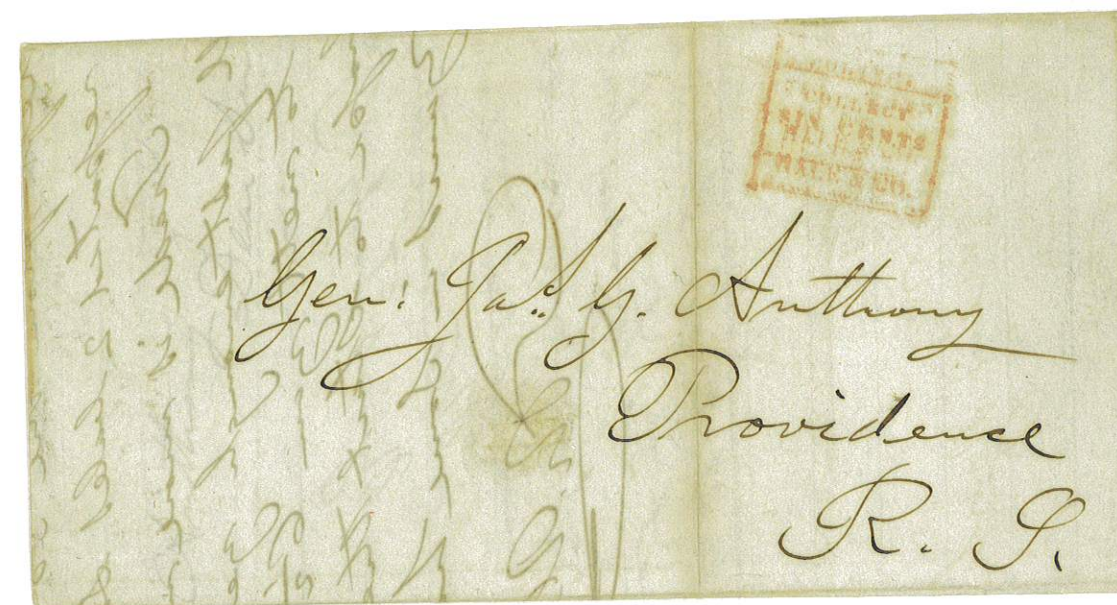

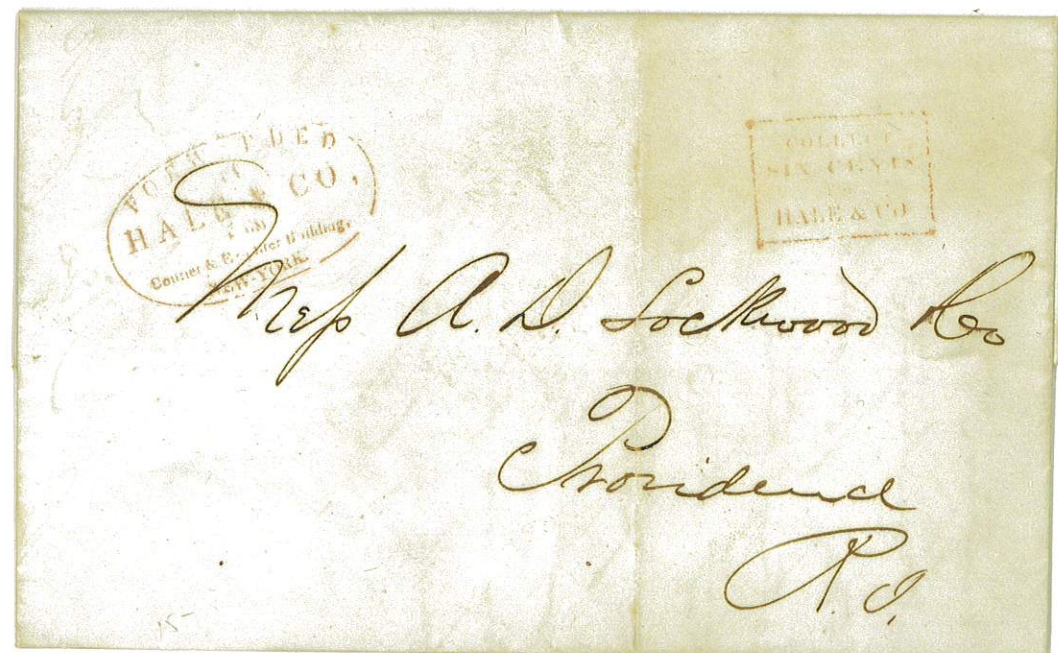
New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated October 22, 1844.

This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red.



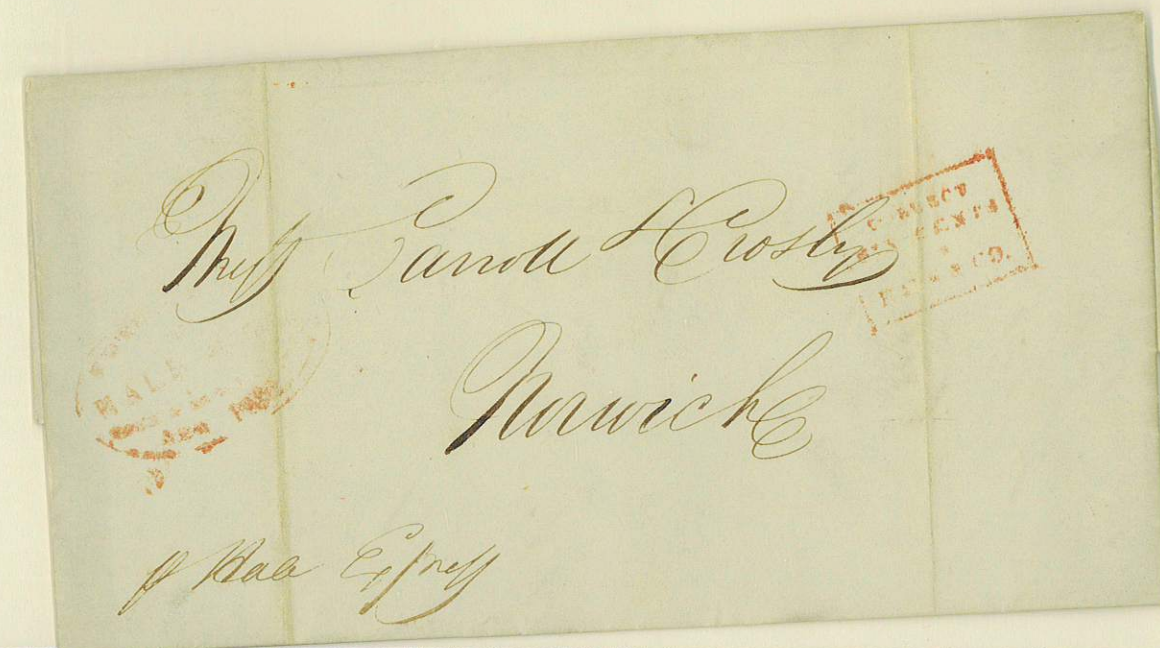

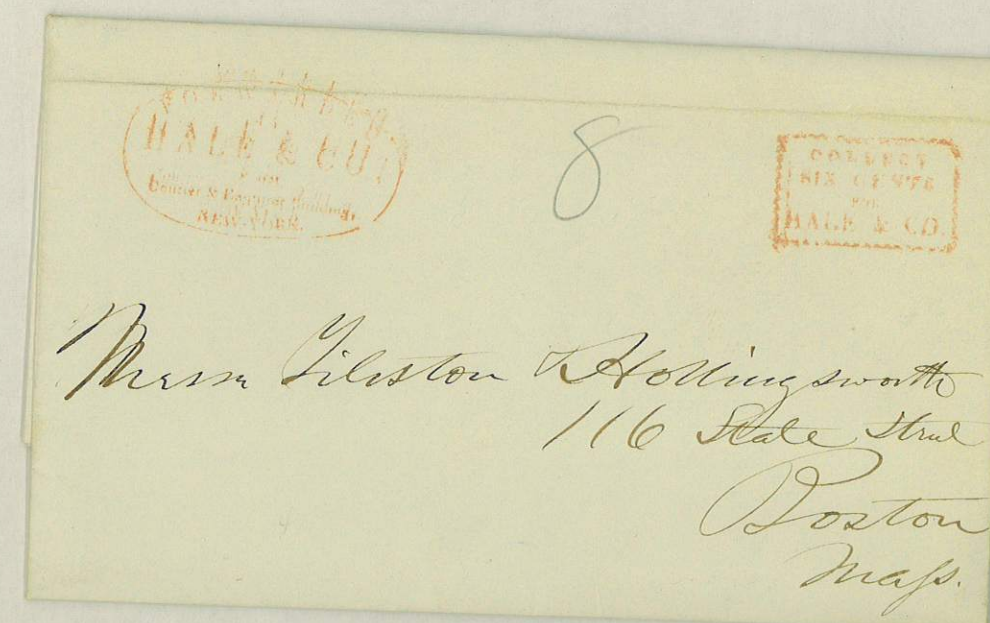

New York City, New York to Springfield, Massachusetts dated November 7, 1844. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. This letter passed through the Hartford, Connecticut office on its way to Springfield where a red Hartford F-19 forwarding handstamp was applied. Also present is a manuscript notation "Single".



New York City to Boston Massachusetts dated 10/28/44. It bears a red F-29 forwarding handstamp, a red C-2 collect handstamp and a manuscript notation "8" indicating local delivery in Boston.



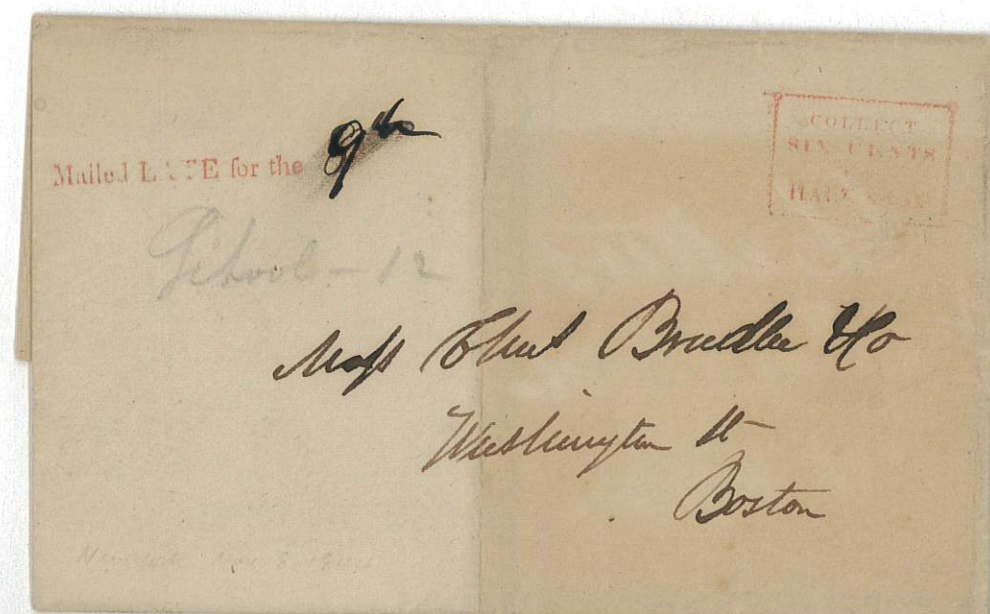
New York City to Boston Massachusetts dated 11/8/44. This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp and a manuscript notation "8" indicating local delivery in Boston.



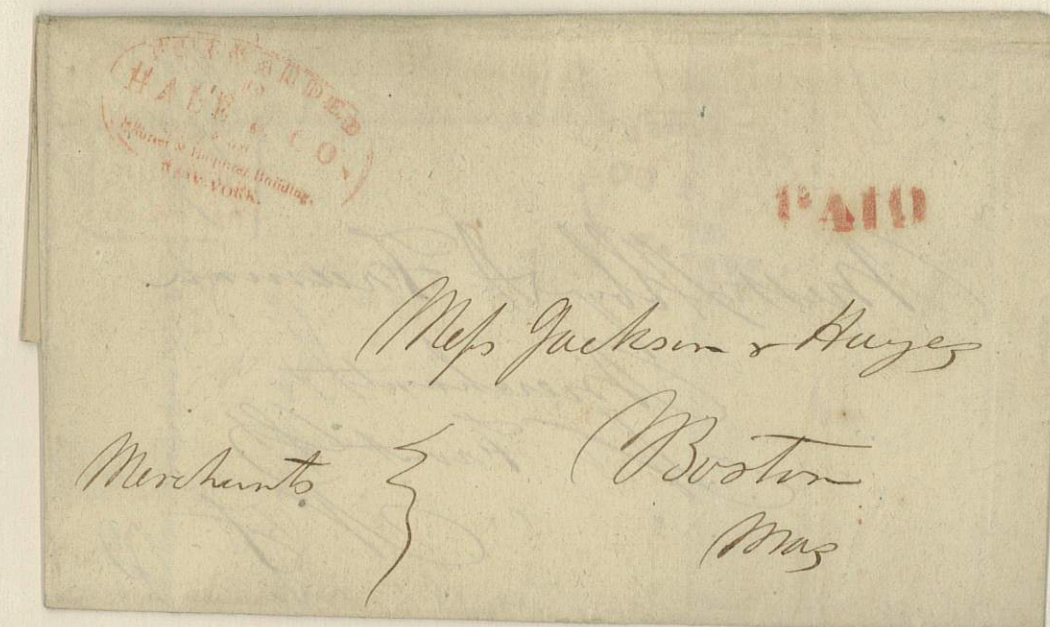

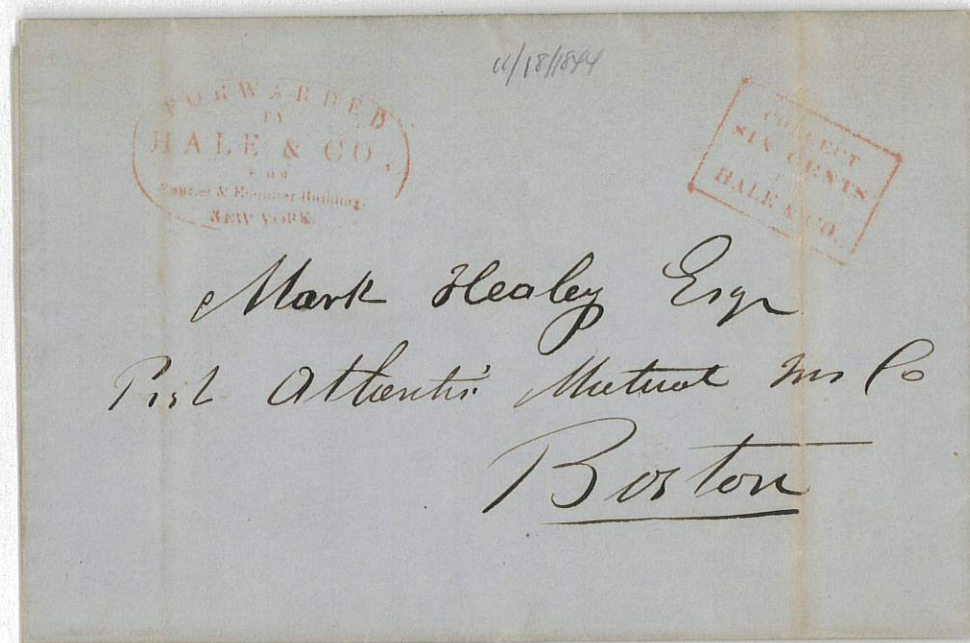

Eighteen ML-3's are known, all in red ink.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated November 1, 1844. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a P-8 paid handstamp, both in red. Also present is a manuscript notation "Merchants".



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated November 18, 1844.
This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red.



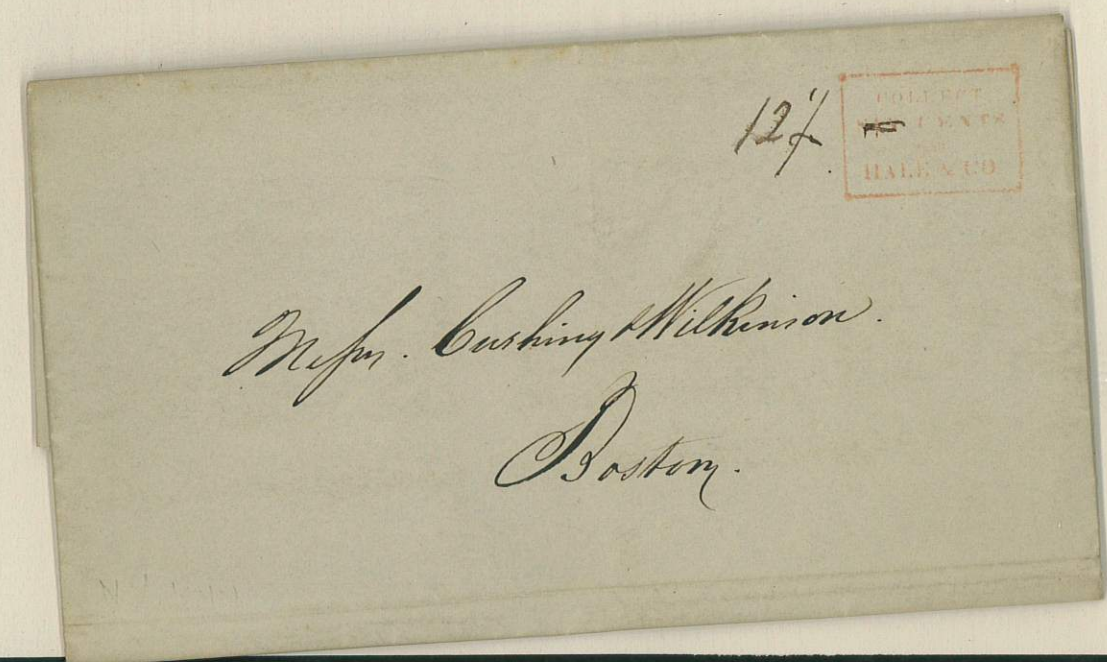
New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts, dated November 16, 1844.

This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp.



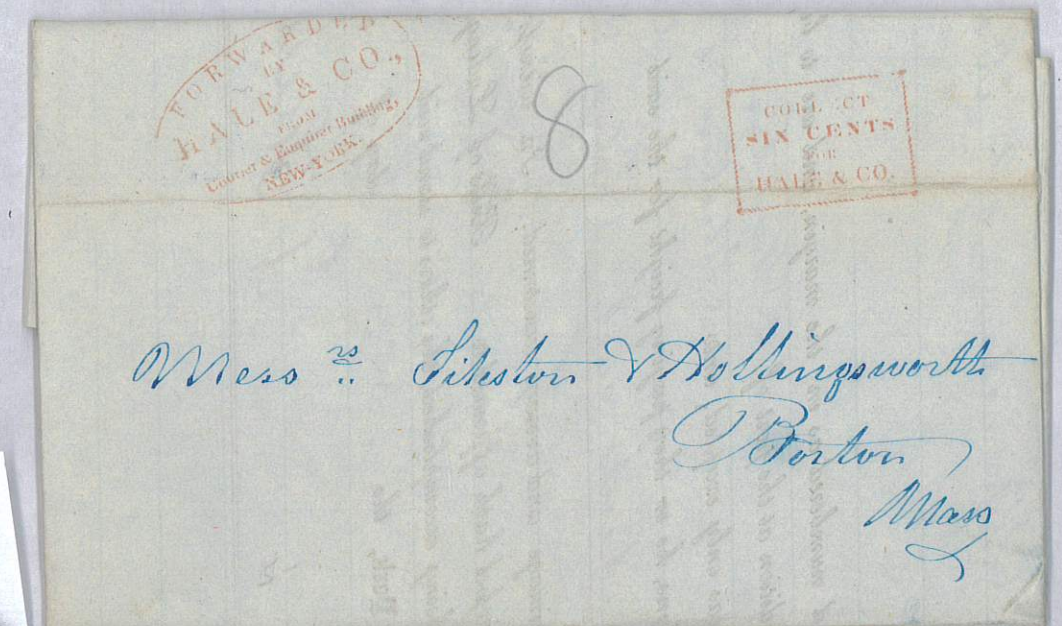

This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp that has the "six" crossed out and a manuscript "12 1/2" applied. This indicates the letter was double weight.



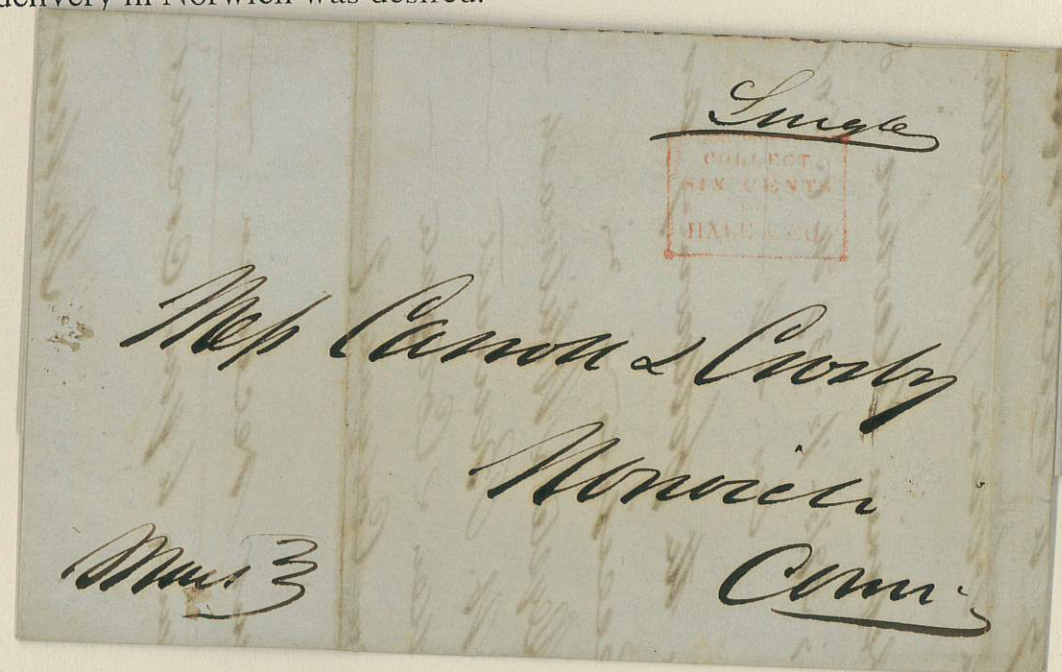

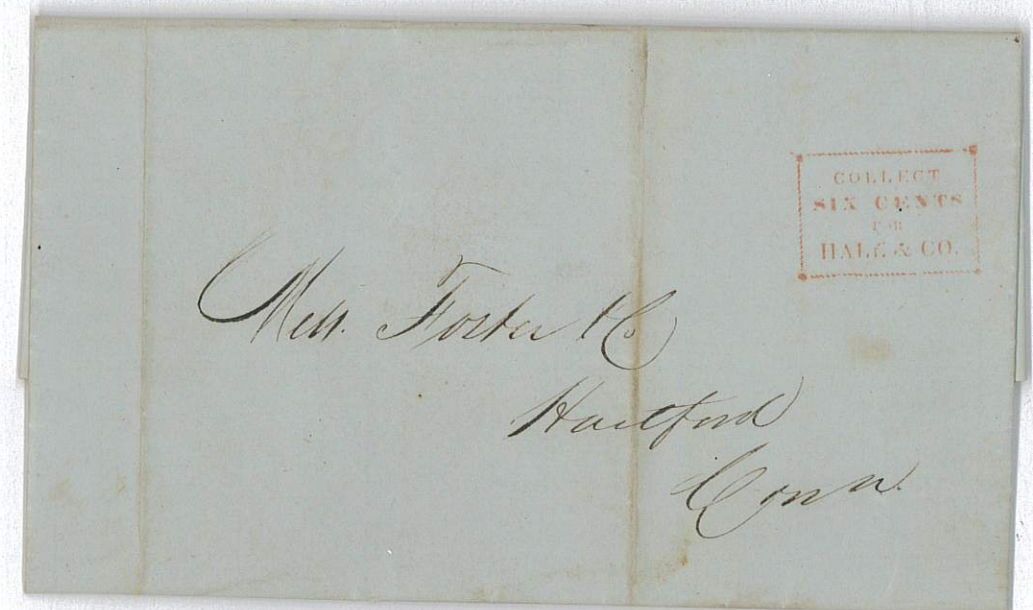

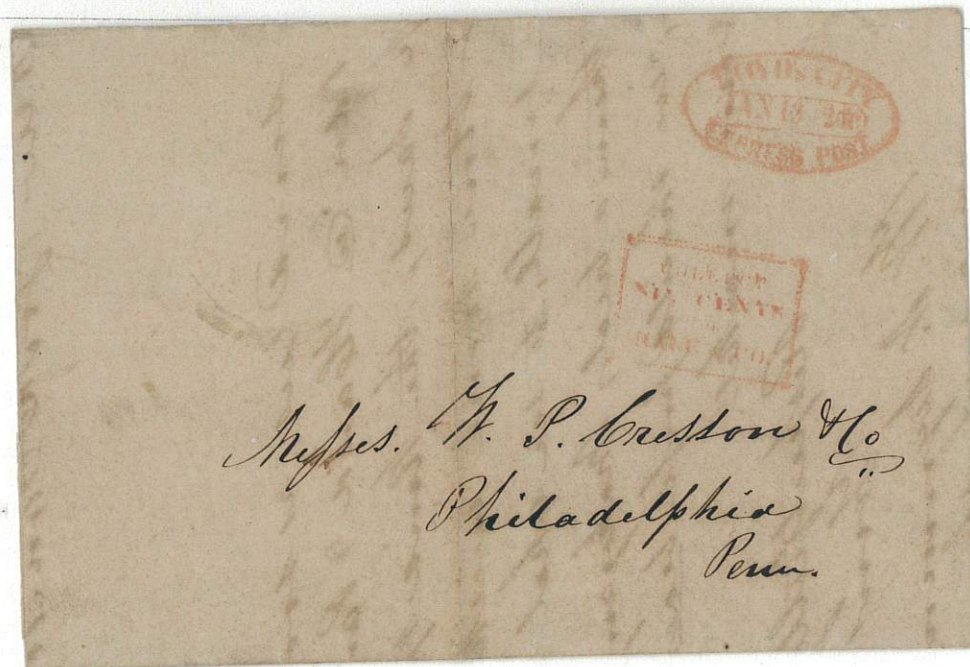

It is not clear why both collect and paid markings appear on this cover. It may be that the PPPaid marking was meant to indicate local delivery in Norwich was desired.



New York City, New York to Hartford, Connecticut dated December 2, 1844. This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated January 11, 1845. This letter bears a red c-3 collect handstamp and a red **Boyd's handstamp**. Boyd delivered this letter to Hale in New York and Hale carried it to Philadelphia.



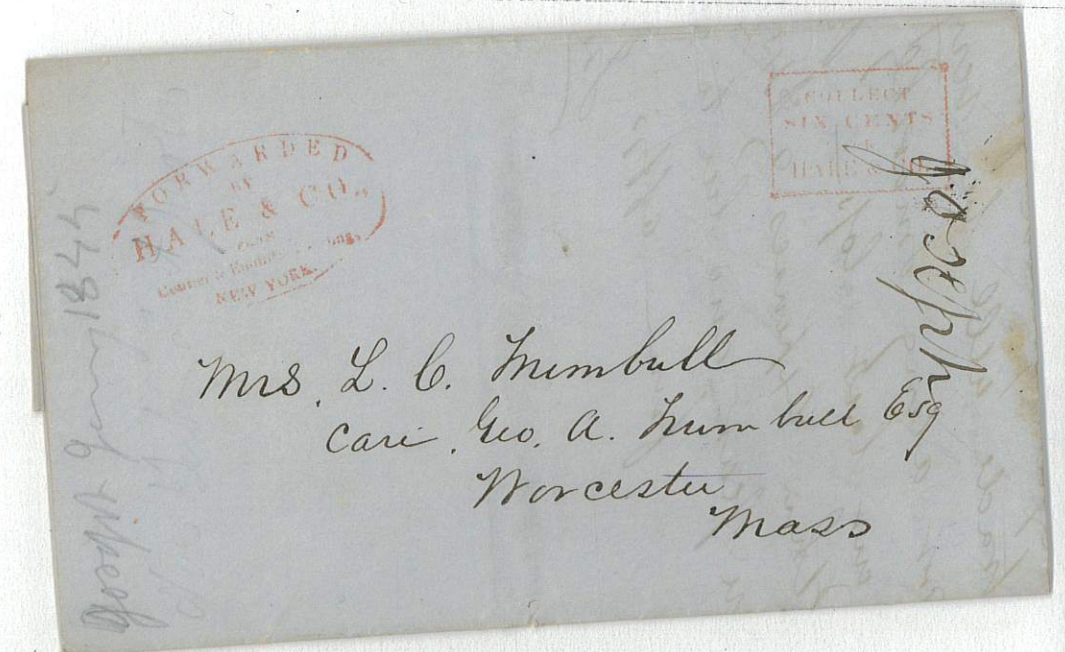
New York City, New York to New Bedford, Massachusetts dated January 2, 1845. This letter bears a red New Bedford C-10 collect handstamp and a red forwarding handstamp from New York that is not Hale. It may be either a Godfrey or Bates handstamp. It is possible that this letter never entered the Hale system but was handled by Bates who used Godfrey's Express to transport the letter to New Bedford. There is a manuscript notation "Godfrey's Express: that supports this assertion.



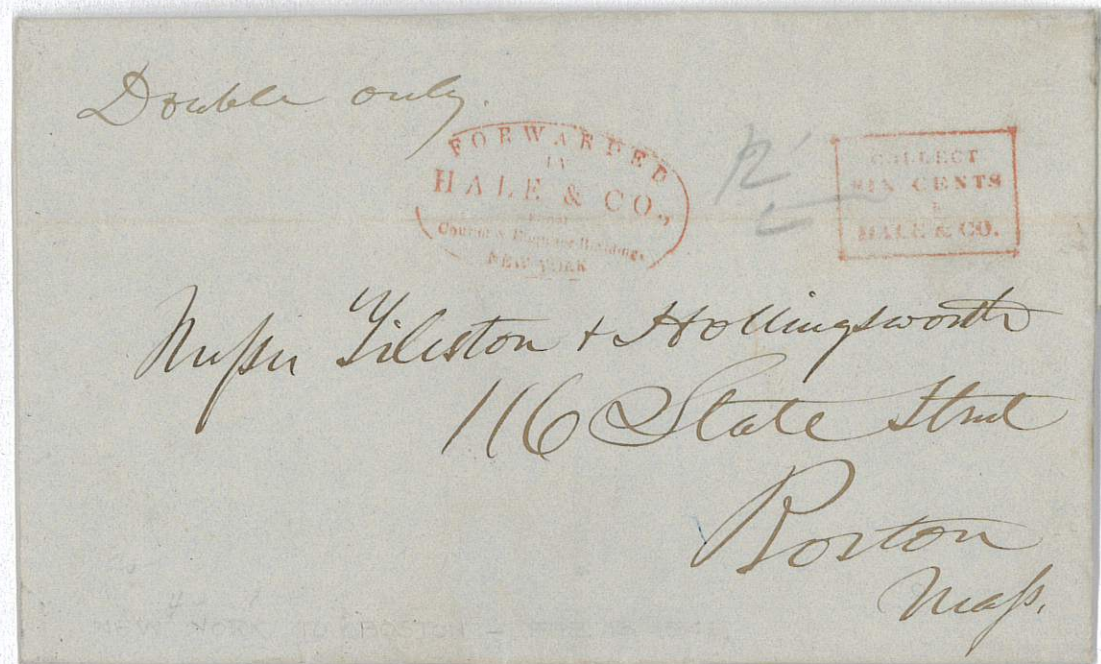
New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated January 7, 1845. This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp.

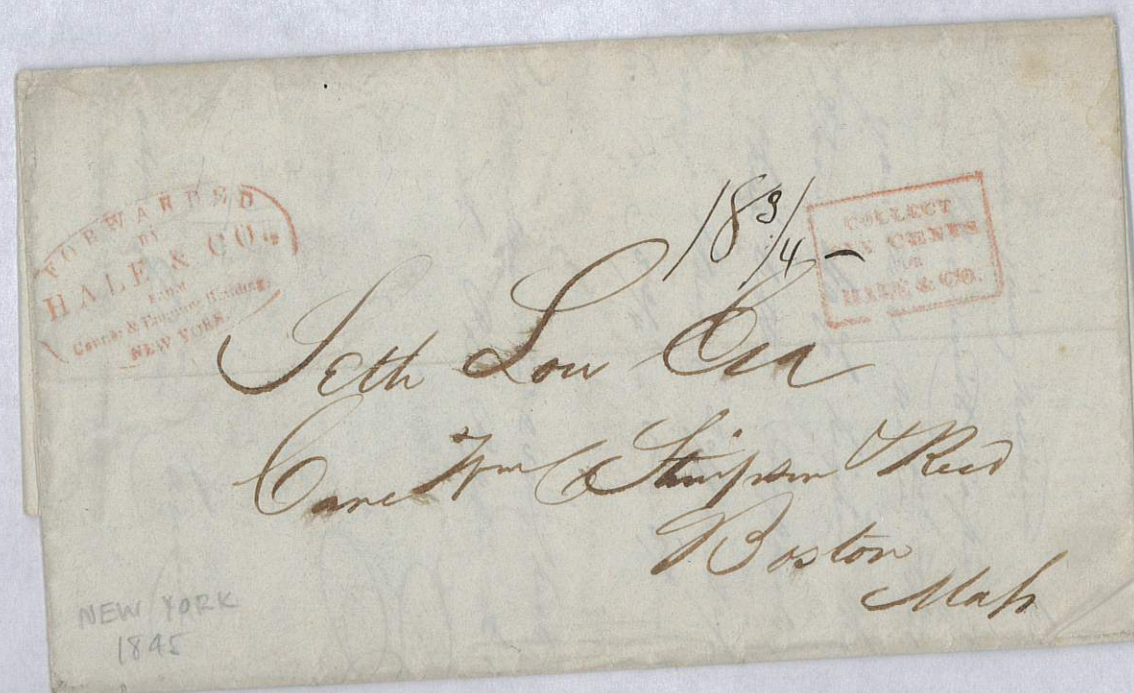

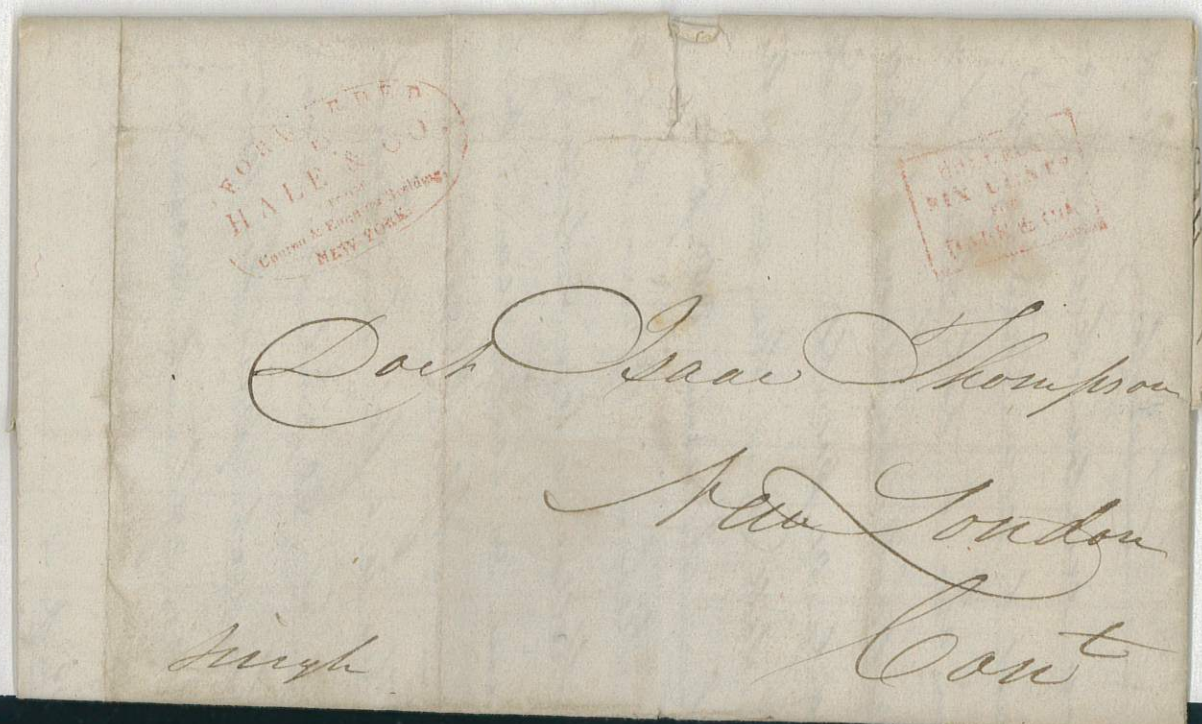

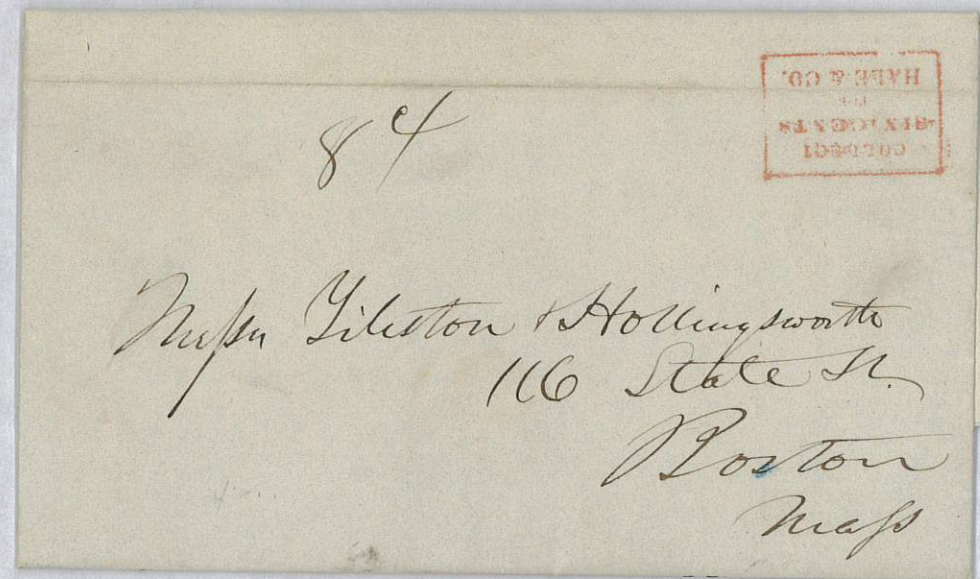

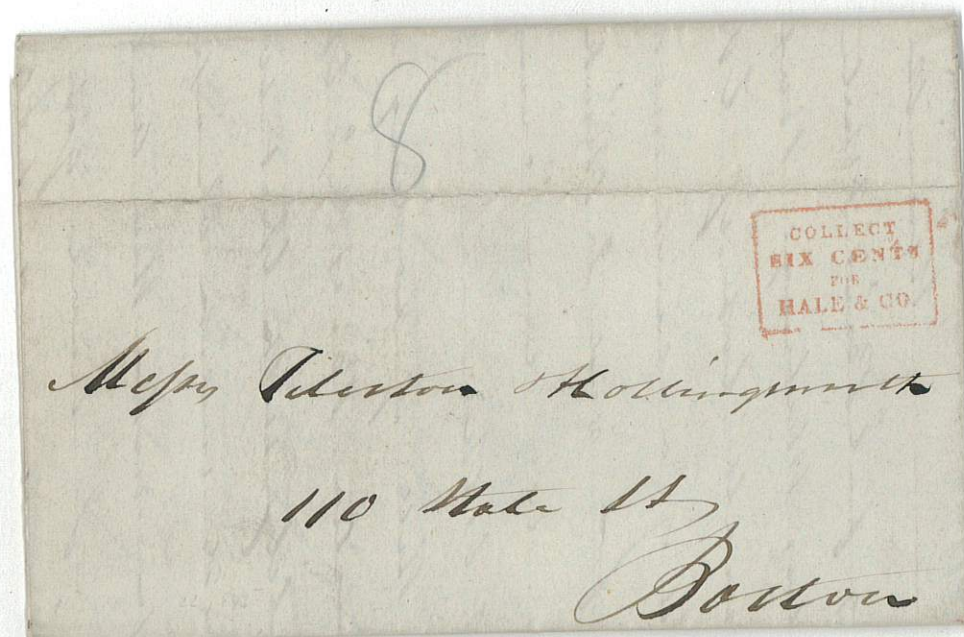

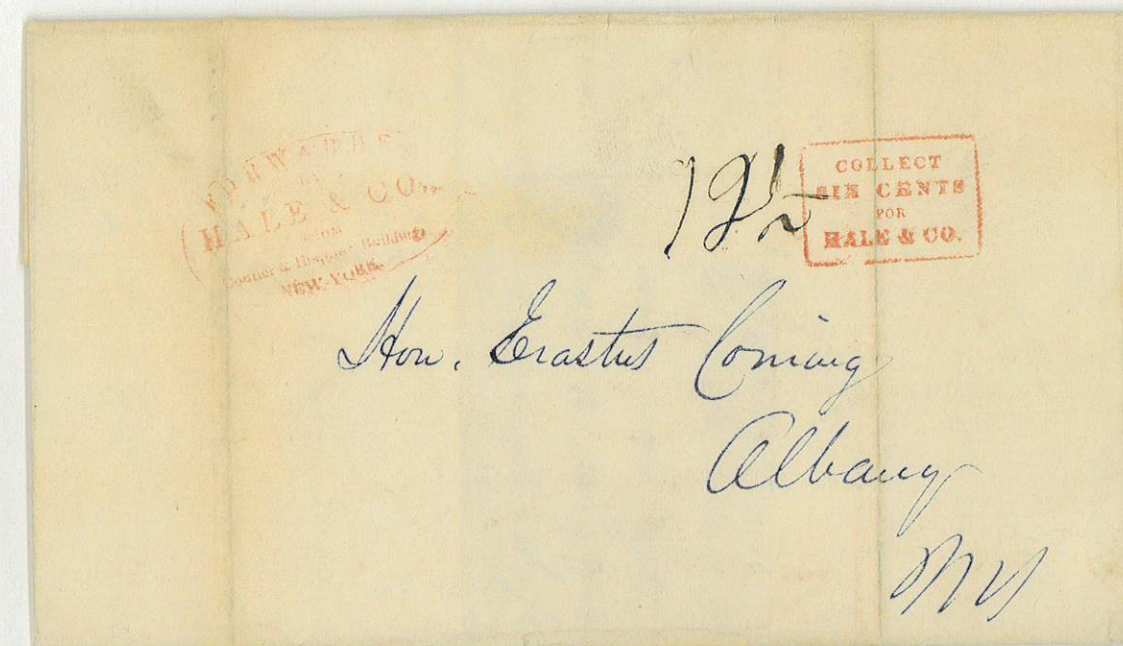

New York City, New York to Troy, New York dated March 14, 1845. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red.



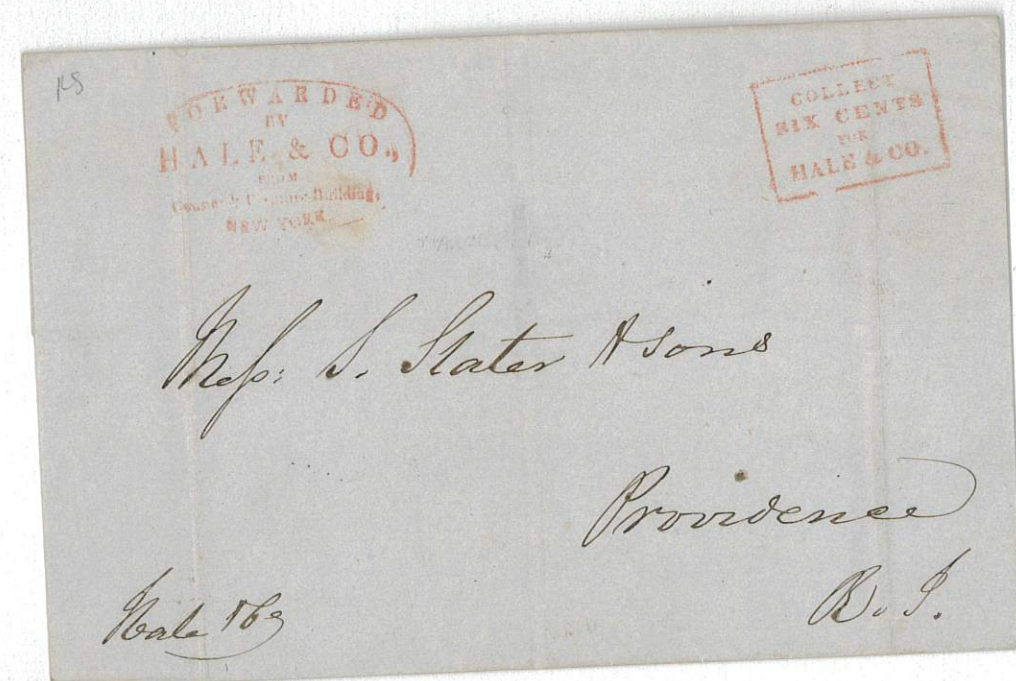

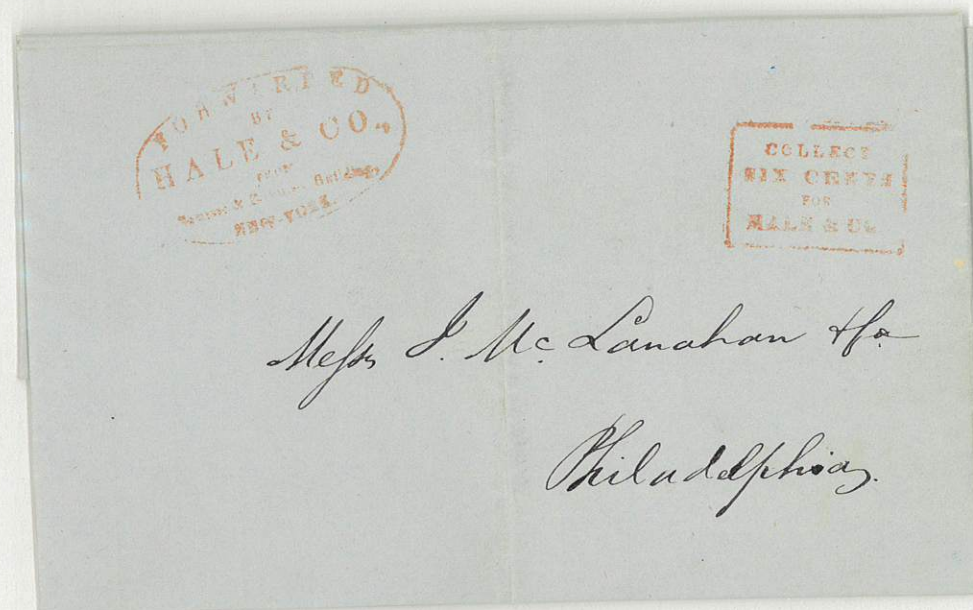

The latter indicates the desire for local delivery in Boston that would be paid for by the addressee. This is the latest known Hale letter with a Boston destination.



New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated June 18, 1845. This letter bears a red C-3 collect handstamp and a '12 1/2' manuscript notation. This is a late use letter dated just 12 days before Hale ceased operation.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated June 26, 1845. This letter bears a red F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. This is the latest known use of both F-29 and C-3. This is also the latest known Hale letter with a Philadelphia destination.



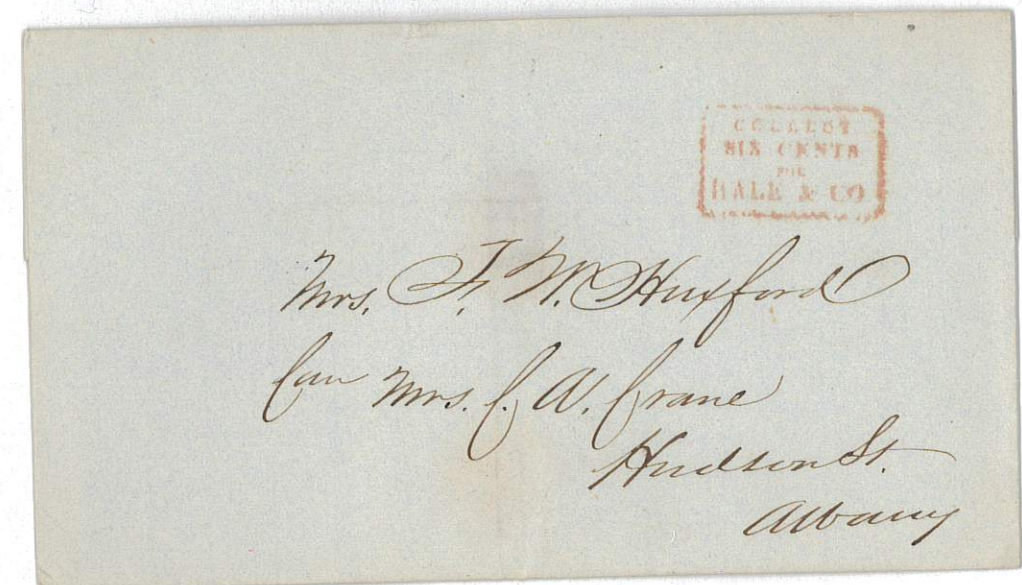

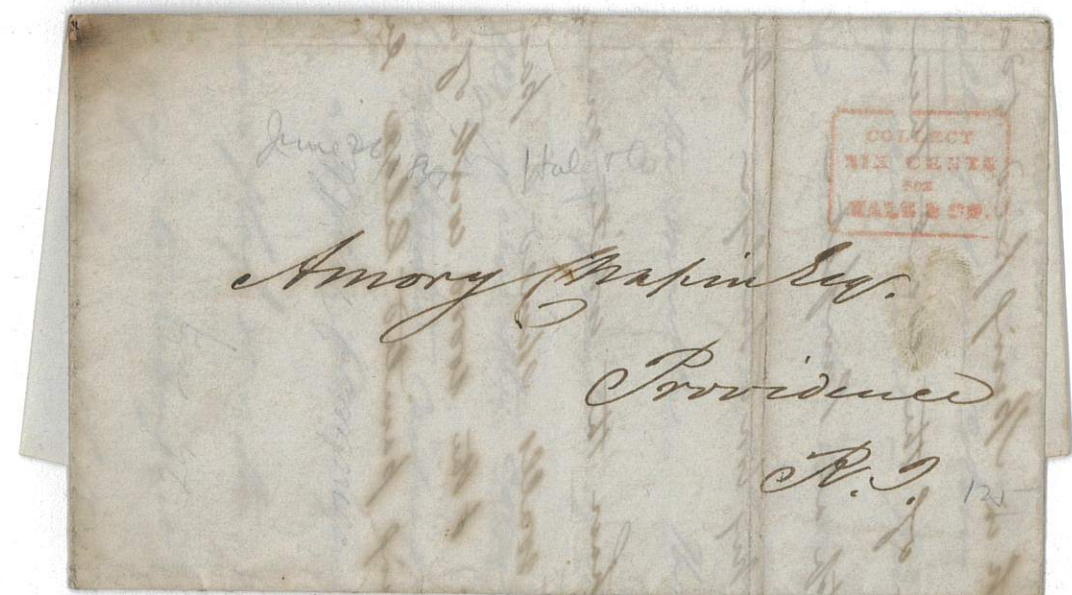
New York City, New York to Albany, New York undated. This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp.

New York City to Boston Massachusetts dated 6/28/45. This letter bears a red C-2 collect handstamp and is the latest known use of C-2 in New York. This letter is just two days before Hale closed his service.
