

New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated September 11, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 that is canceled with a C-2 collect handstamp in red. Also present is a F-28 forwarding handstamp and a manuscript "2c" notation. The latter indicates that delivery to the addressee in Boston is desired. It is not clear why the C-2 is present since the 75L1 should have been sufficient to pay the postage.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated June 6, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 with a "6" manuscript cancel. Also present is a manuscript "2C" perhaps indicating that local delivery in Boston was desired.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated October 2, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 with a black cross cancel and a red F-28 forwarding handstamp.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated June 13, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 with a red indistinct cancel. Also present is a manuscript notation "2 cts" indicating local delivery in Boston was desired.





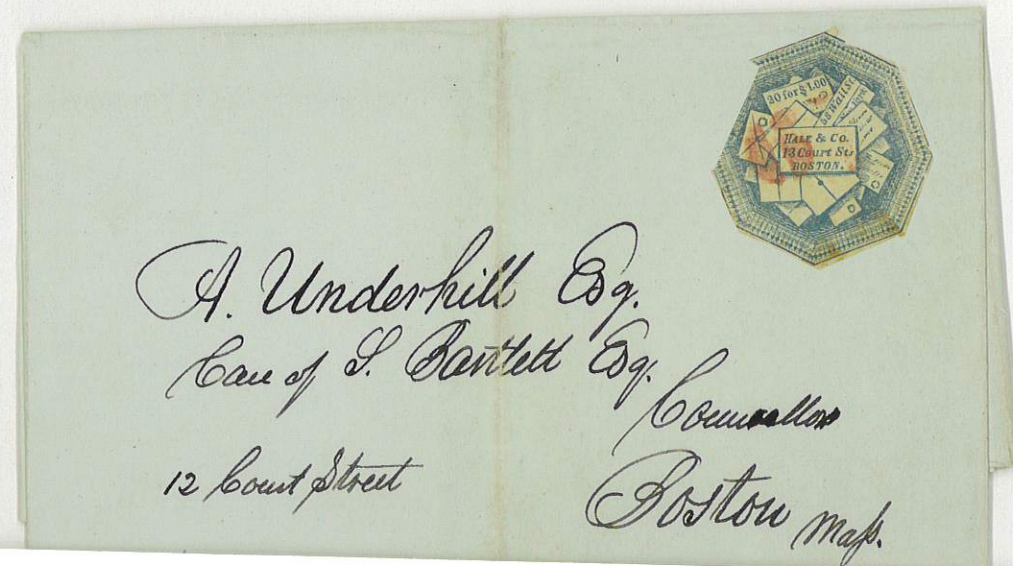
New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated October 14, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 that is canceled with a red P-8 paid handstamp.



New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated 10/15/44. It bears a square cut 75L1 and a red New York P-8 paid handstamp.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated June 14, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 that has a C-14 red cancel. It is not clear why the C-14 was applied to the 75L1. It is possible the letter was overweight or that the C-14 was just used to cancel the 75L1.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated June 14, 1844. This letter bears a 75L1 that has a C-14 red cancel. It is not clear why the C-14 was applied to the 75L1. It is possible the letter was overweight or that the C-14 was just used to cancel the 75L1. Also present is the manuscript notation "H. Wolfe June 14, 1844".





**New York City, New York** to Norwich, Connecticut dated September 21, 1844.  
This letter bears a 75L5 and a F-28 forwarding handstamp in red. Also present is the manuscript notation "prepaid".



**New York City, New York** to Providence, Rhode Island dated March 1, 1845.  
The letter bears a red F-29 forwarding handstamp and a 75L1 canceled with a manuscript "N". The "N" cancel was used frequently in Providence and was probably applied to cancel the 75L1. Also present is a manuscript "2c" indicating that local delivery in Providence was desired and would be paid.



**New York City, New York** to Providence, Rhode Island dated October 26, 1844.  
This letter bears a 75L5 canceled with a red P-8 paid handstamp. Also present is a red F-29 forwarding handstamp.



**New York City, New York** to Providence, Rhode Island dated August 24, 1844.  
This letter bears a 75L5 canceled with a F-28 forwarding handstamp in red.

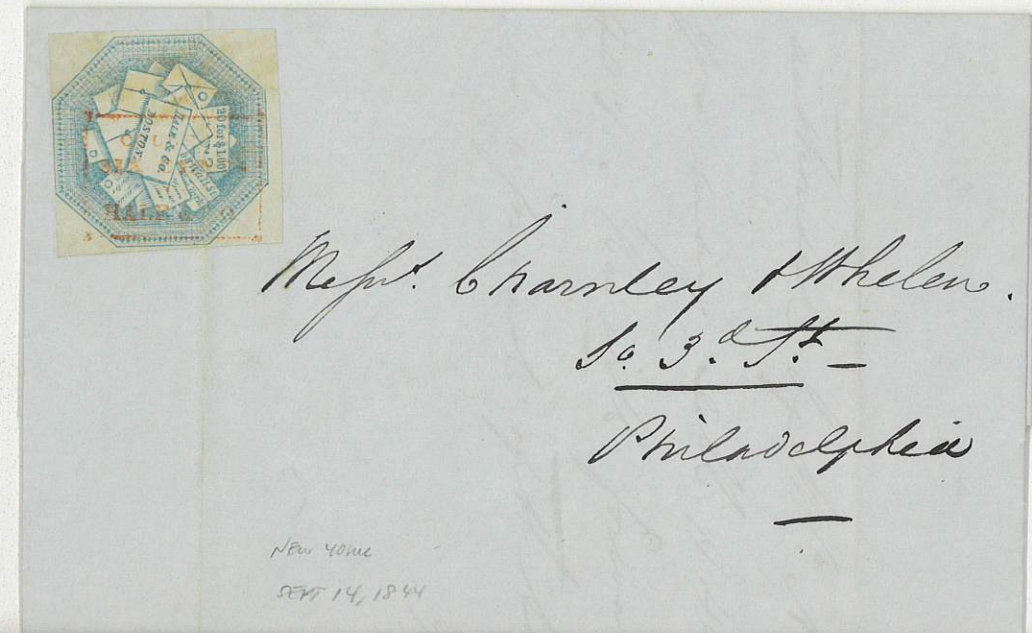




New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated November 27, 1844.  
This letter bears two red F-29 forwarding handstamps, one canceling the 75L5.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated September 14, 1844. This letter bears a square cut 75L5 and a C-3 collect handstamp. The 75L5 should have paid the postage but the letter may have been overweight requiring another 6 cents and the C-3 was therefore added. It may have been a method of canceling the 75L5 where a paid handstamp should have been applied.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated December 24, 1844.  
This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. The C-3 cancels and ties the 75L5 that is also present.



New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated September 16, 1844. This letter bears a 75L5 that is canceled with a red C-3 collect handstamp. It is not clear why the C-3 is present on this letter except perhaps as a cancel for the 75L5.





New York City, New York to Middletown, Connecticut dated April 24, 1845.  
This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and two C-3 collect handstamps, all in red. The C-3's cancel and tie the 75L5 to the cover. This is the latest known Hale Middletown destination cover.



New York City, New York to New Haven, Connecticut dated April 25, 1845.  
This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a P-8 paid handstamp, both in red. The P-8 was used to cancel the 75L5.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated January 23, 1845.  
This letter bears a 75L5 canceled with a red C-3 collect handstamp and a red F-29 forwarding handstamp.

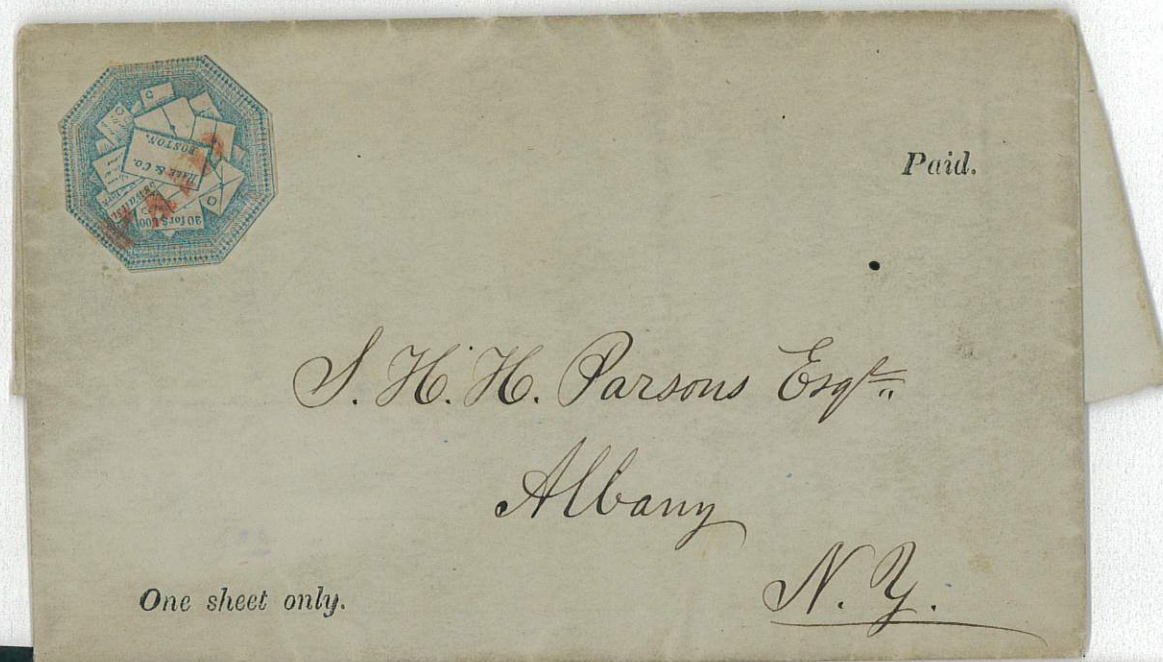


New York City, New York to Providence, Rhode Island dated February 7, 1845.  
This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a P-8 paid handstamp, both in red. The P-8 cancels and ties the 75L5 to the letter.





New York City, New York to Albany, New York dated May 5, 1845. This letter bears a 75L5 with a P-8 red cancel. This is a printed sheet that shows the words "Paid" and "One sheet only" on the front.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated February 28, 1845. This letter bears a 75L5 that is canceled with a red C-3 collect handstamp.



New York City, New York to Boston, Massachusetts dated May 10, 1845. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a P-8 paid handstamp, both in red. The 75L5 is canceled by the P-8 paid handstamp.



New York City, New York to Middletown, Connecticut dated March 19, 1845. This letter bears only a 75L5 and no Hale handstamps.





New York City, New York to Hartford, Connecticut dated May 16, 1845. This letter bears a 75L5 that is canceled with a red P-8 paid handstamp. Also present are the manuscript notations "Paid" and "2". The latter indicates that local delivery in Hartford was desired and would be paid for.



New York City, New York to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania dated May 23, 1845. This letter bears a F-29 forwarding handstamp and a C-3 collect handstamp, both in red. The C-3 cancels and ties the 75L5 to the cover. Also present under the 75L5 is a manuscript "Paid" notation.
