Map of China

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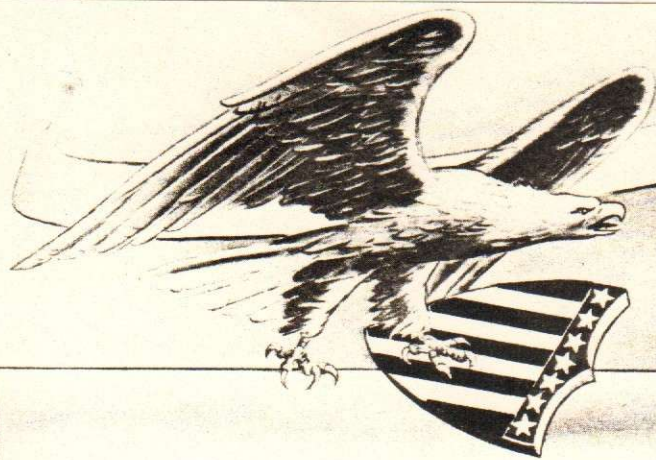
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CHINA 1942

Liberty with Torch of Freedom

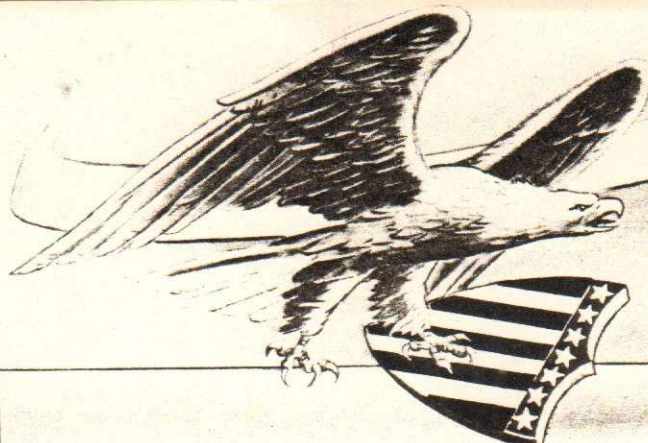
Issued in conjunction with the war effort and to impress upon the public the necessity of spreading the gospel of the Four Freedoms throughout the world.
