KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, FUKUMATU ITO, of Honolulu, City and County of Honolulu, Territory of Hawaii, hereinafter designated the Mortgagor, for and in consideration of the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) to me in hand paid by IHACHI YAMAMOTO, of the same place, hereinafter designated the Mortgagee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto IHACHI YAMAMOTO, his heirs and assigns, all that certain parcel of land situate at Auwaiolimu in the City and County of Honolulu aforesaid, being the same premises conveyed to me by deed of Carlos A. Long, dated the 6th day of December, 1912, and of record in liber _____ on page _____, and known and designated as Lot 10, (ten) in Olomana Tract, a plan of said Tract being on file in the office of the Registrar of Conveyances in Honolulu aforesaid, and registered as Wap Numbered 69, and containing an area of 5540 square feet.

TO HAVE and TO HOLD the above granted premises with all rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Mortgagee, his heirs and assigns forever.
