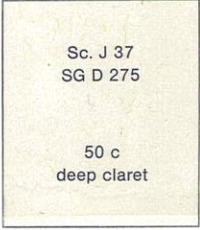

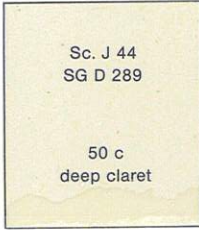

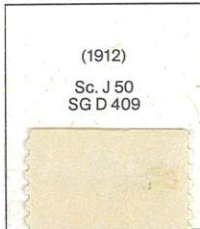

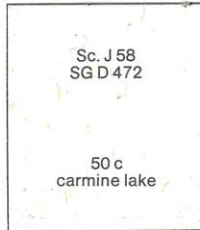
Single Line Wmk. USPS - 1910/12 - Perf. 12, Deep Claret
