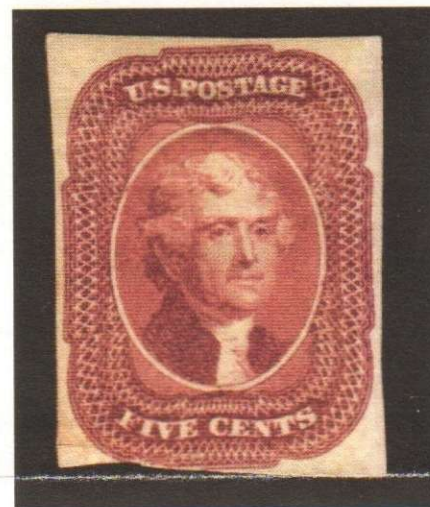

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the United States of America Post Office in 1862, "George Washington" 24 cents grey, perforated 12.0 x 12.0, on medium white wove paper without watermark, without grill, Scott Classics Specialized Catalogue #78b, unused, a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 125% of true size, and am of the opinion that:

The stamp submitted is genuine, unused, but has been **regummed**. There are a few short perforations at right. There is a small black stain on the left shoulder, and a bit of toning near the right margin. These spots do not indicate the presence of a cancellation.
