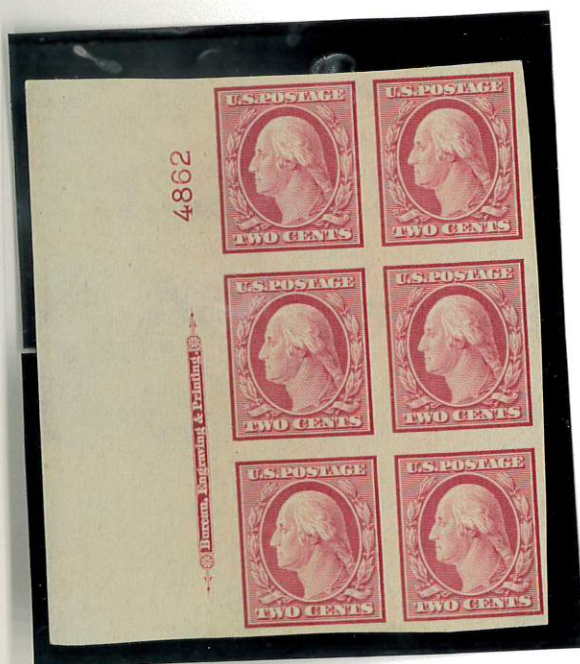

To mark the 100th anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln (1809-1865), the 16th President of the United States, a special stamp was issued in three forms: perforated, imperforate and perforated on an experimental "bluish paper." The head of Lincoln pictured on the stamp is from the famous Grant Park statue in Chicago, by the renowned American sculptor Augustus Saint-Gaudens.

ALASKA-YUKON PACIFIC EXPOSITION

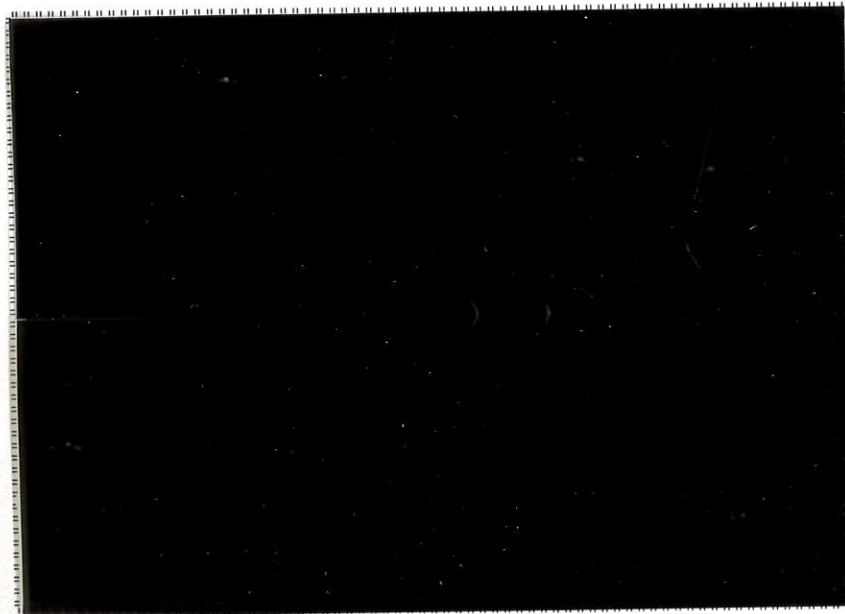


William H. Seward (1801-1872) was the distinguished United States Secretary of State under both U. S. Presidents Lincoln and Johnson. When the Russians discovered that profits from the fur trade were dropping they were willing to sell Alaska, and Seward negotiated the purchase for \$7,200,000.

HUDSON-FULTON CELEBRATION



For the 300th anniversary of the arrival of Henry Hudson in New York aboard his famous ship "Half-Moon", and the 102nd anniversary of Robert Fulton's first trip in his steamboat "Clermont," a special stamp was issued picturing both historic vessels. At the time, ships from many of the world's navies gathered in New York harbor to celebrate the occasion.
