Private metal dies cancel stamps paying tax on documents

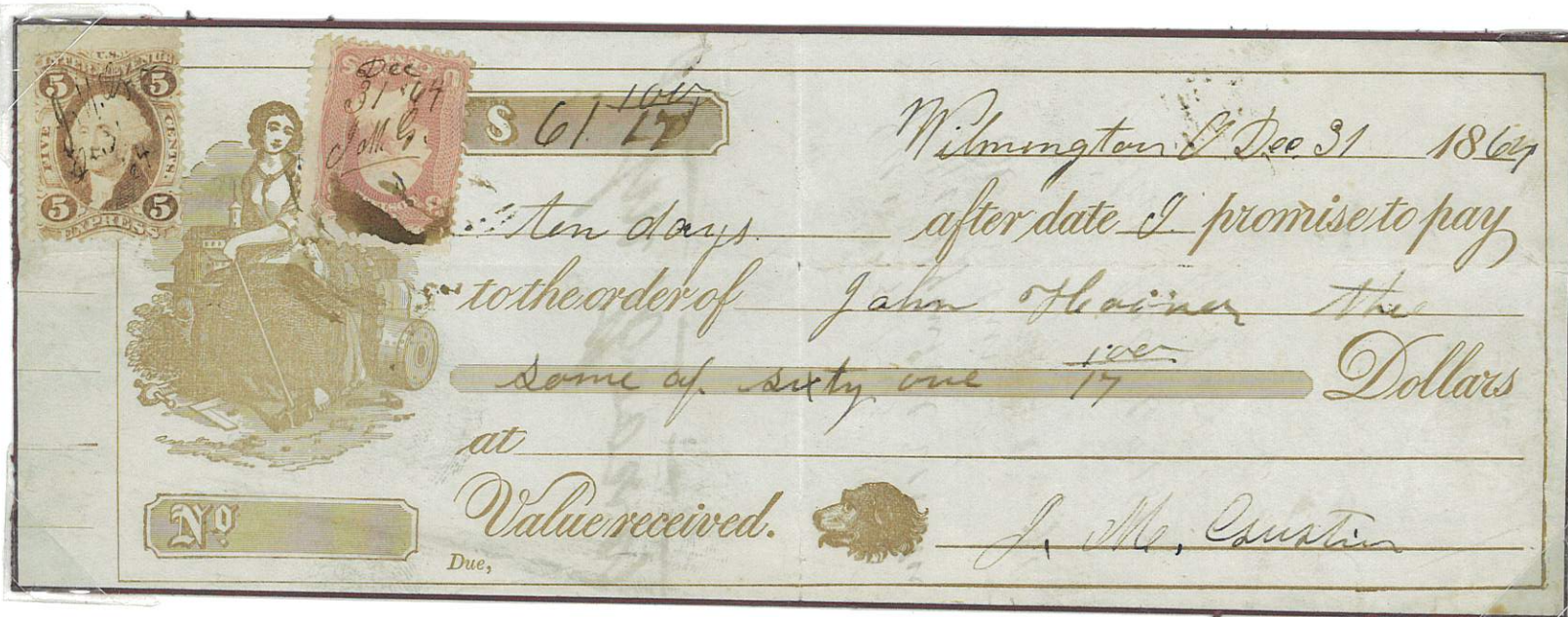

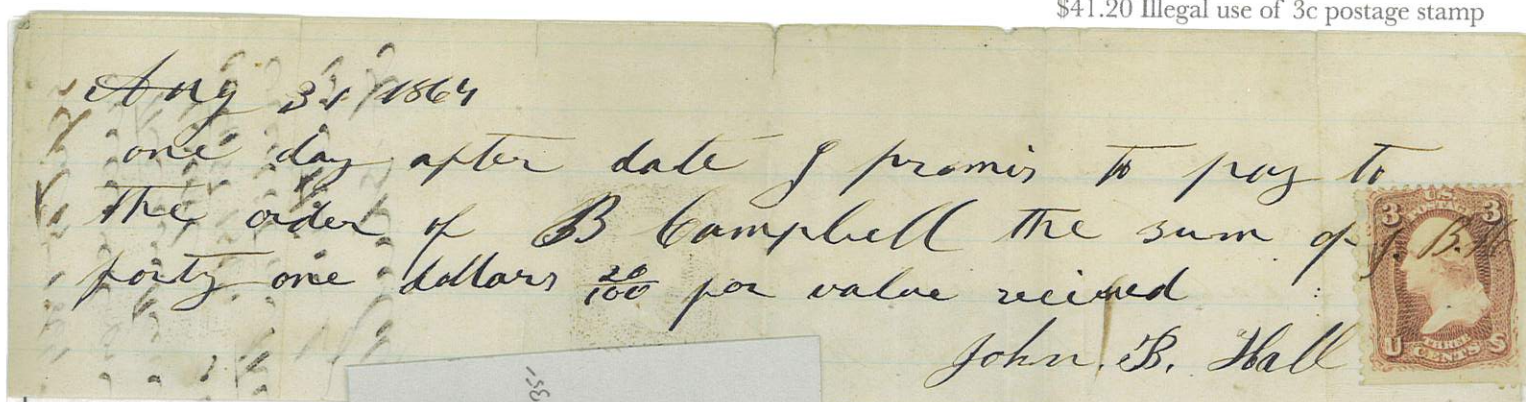

The rate per act of 1864, was 5c per \$100. Paying with a 3c stamp was both illegal and insufficient. The 5c revenue stamp makes the document legal (Dec 31st, 1864).

Insufficient tax paid on promise to pay
\$41.20 Illegal use of 3c postage stamp

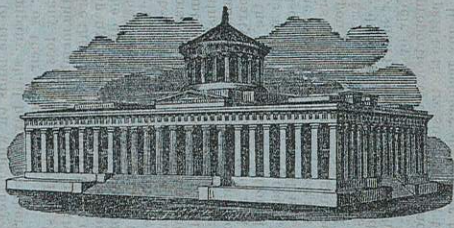
