The Bay View post office was located in a drug store operated by Joseph Feeney. When James Kelly took over as post master the office was located in a building on the corner of New York Avenue (Bay Street) and Maryland Avenue. A house in the rear occupied by a Mr. Mc Tenney caught fire and as a result the building in which the post office was situated was destroyed by the fire.



Cover from Wabasha, Minnesota, cancelled on August 19, 1862, addressed to a Miss Ella F. Shilton in Bay View, Staten Island, New York. The addressee had moved to Middlebury, Connecticut. The cover was manuscript cancelled at Bay View on August 22, 1862 and forwarded with the additional charge of three cents in manuscript. ("Forwarded 3")

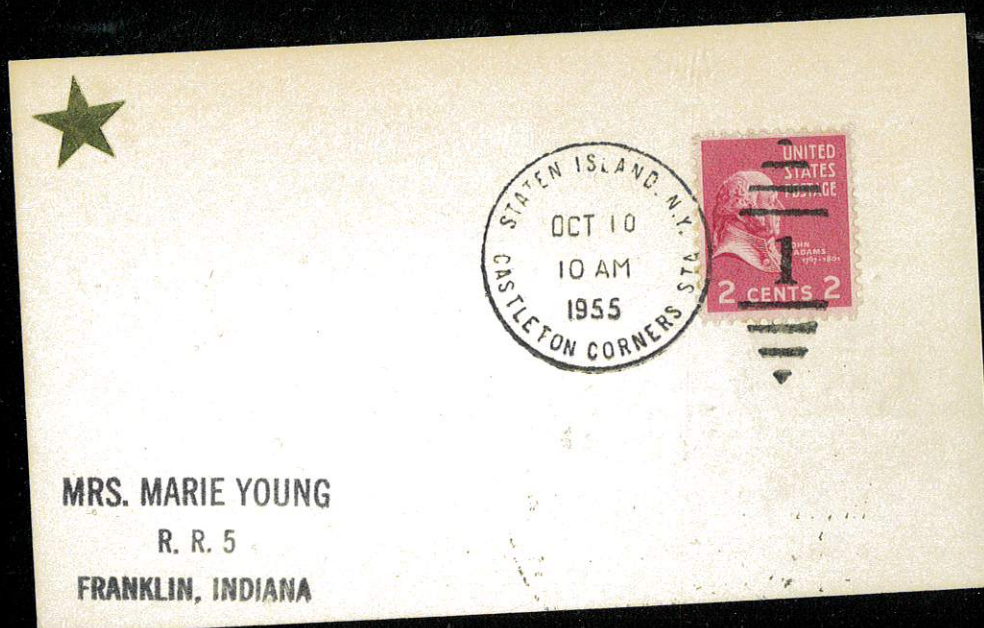
1948 Castleton Corners Station Mark

Eltingville was formerly served by Sea Side. Named for a resident named Elting. In the days of plank roads this part of Staten Island was a popular resort area. The plank road which went through Eltingville started at the Brerger Point Ferry in Port Richmond and ran through Granitville, Bull's Head, New Springville, Green Ridge and ended at Sea Side.

The Fresh Kills Bridge was erected by the Plank Road Company and the road leading from Green Ridge to the Amboy Road at Eltingville was built on private property. (Staten Island Histoy, Morris, Vol. 2. Page 442)

NOTE; Eltingville was between Green Ridge and Sea Side.

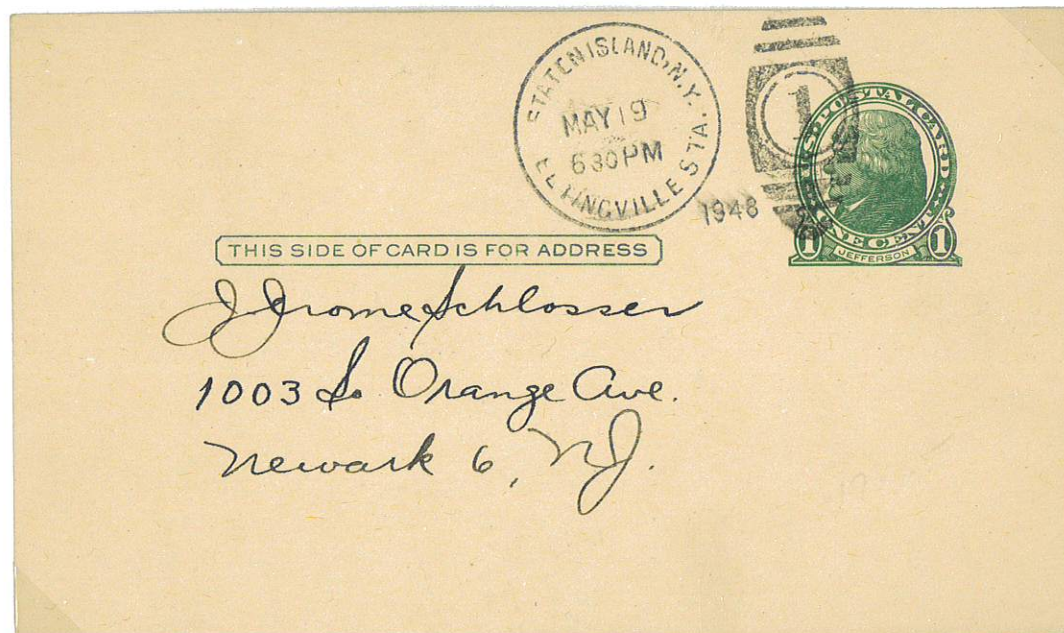

A post office, Fort Wadsworth Station existed there from February 16, 1942 until October 15, 1964.

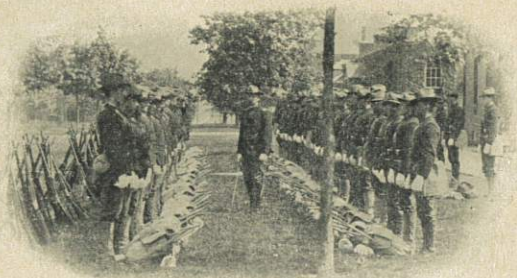

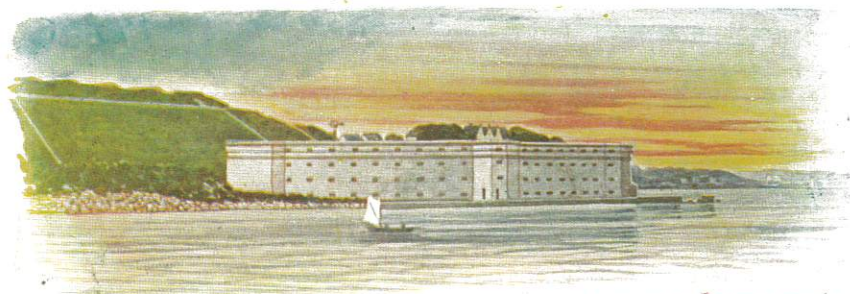

Fort Wadsworth was named after Brigadier General James S. Wadsworth who died of wounds received in "The Battle of the Wilderness" on May 8, 1864.

Fort Wadsworth was previously called Fort Tompkins and Fort Richmond came into use on November 7, 1865.

The change of the name to Fort Wadsworth was reported in the Richmond County Gazette, November 29, 1865.

## FOX HILLS STATION

Fox Hills Hospital, officially known as Hoff General Hospital No.41., was built to care for the casualties of World War I. The institution was constructed on approximately one mile of land that had previously been the Fox Hills Country Club.

The U.S. Public Health Service took over the facility in 1920 and shortly afterwards a phase-out was commenced. In 1921 there were 865 employees and 530 patients, the last of whom were transferred to Sea View and other hospitals in 1923.

The Fox Hills Hospital was the scene of terrible suffering that was long remembered. However, few Staten Islanders today know that the facility ever existed.

A post office was located at the hospital. It was called Fox Hills Station. It was opened on March 25, 1918 and closed on March 31, 1922.

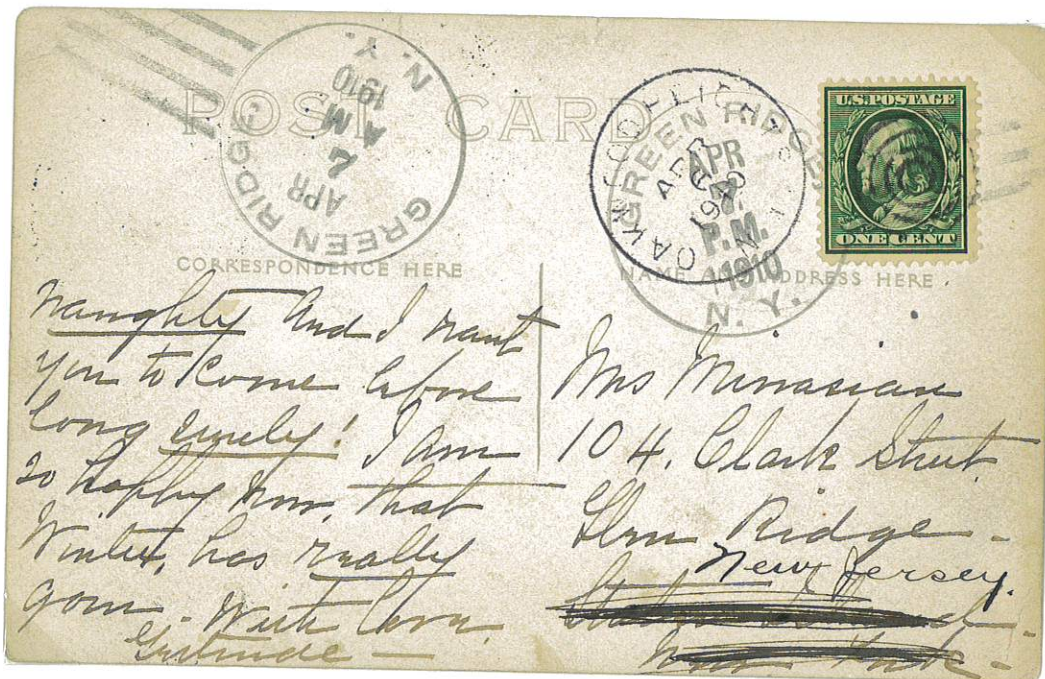

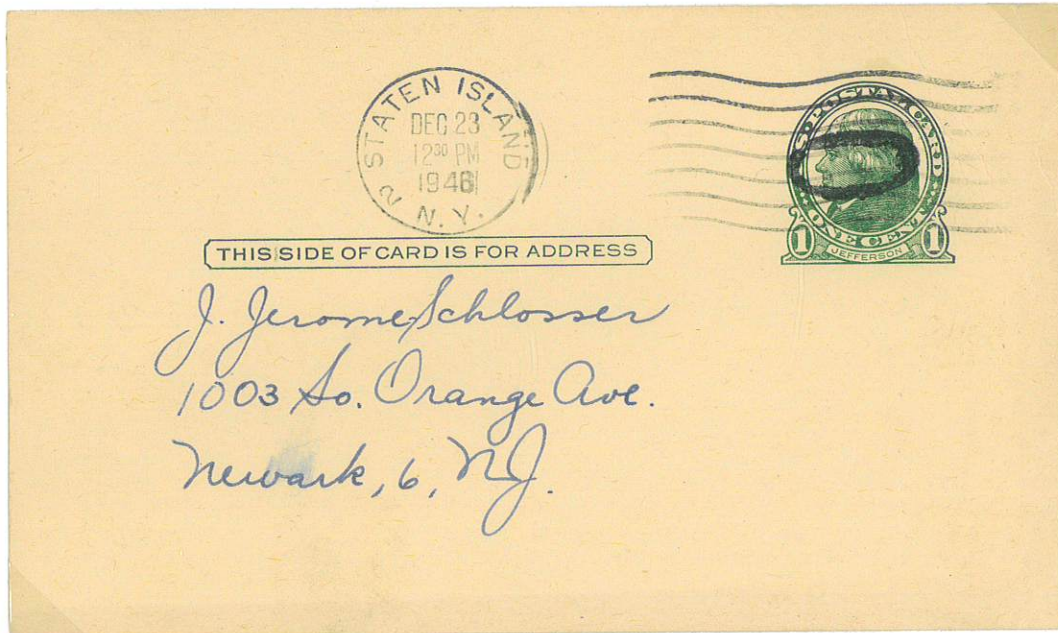

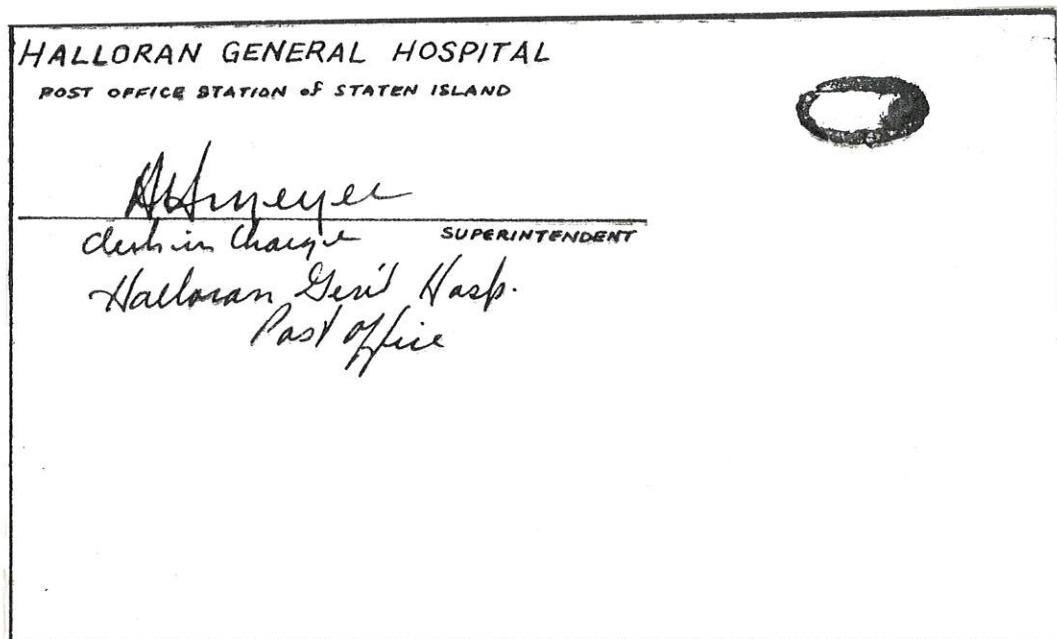


HALLORAN GENERAL HOSPITAL

The hospital that is known today as Willowbrook was originally intended to be a children's hospital. However, wounded soldiers of World War II took priority and it was opened as Halloran General Hospital. A post office existed there from February 22, 1943 until February 14, 1947. All mail was cancelled at the main post office.

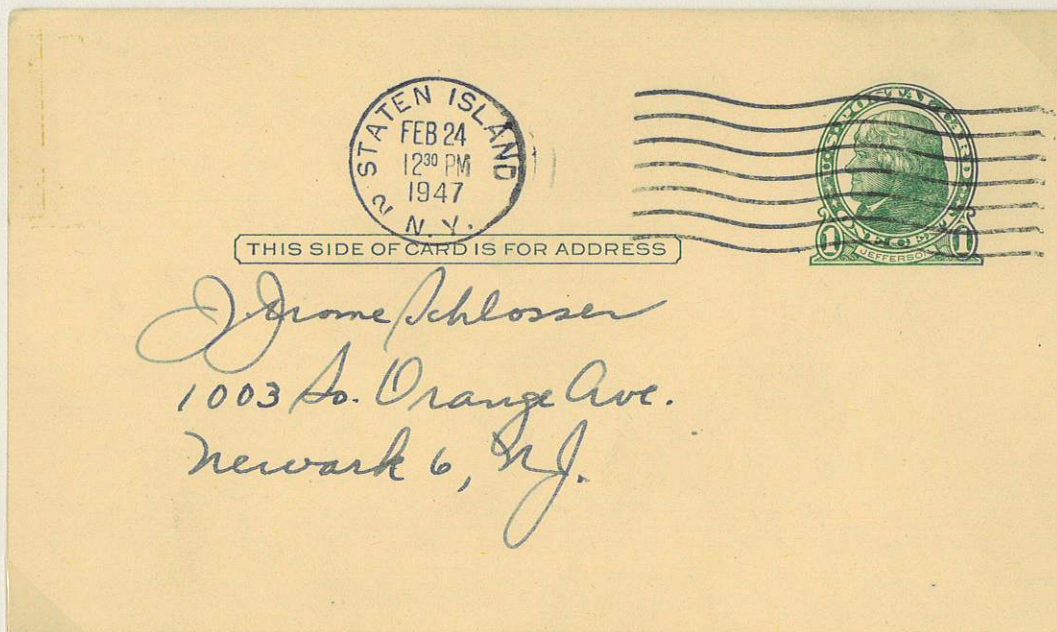


Halloran General Hospital Mark on reverse.

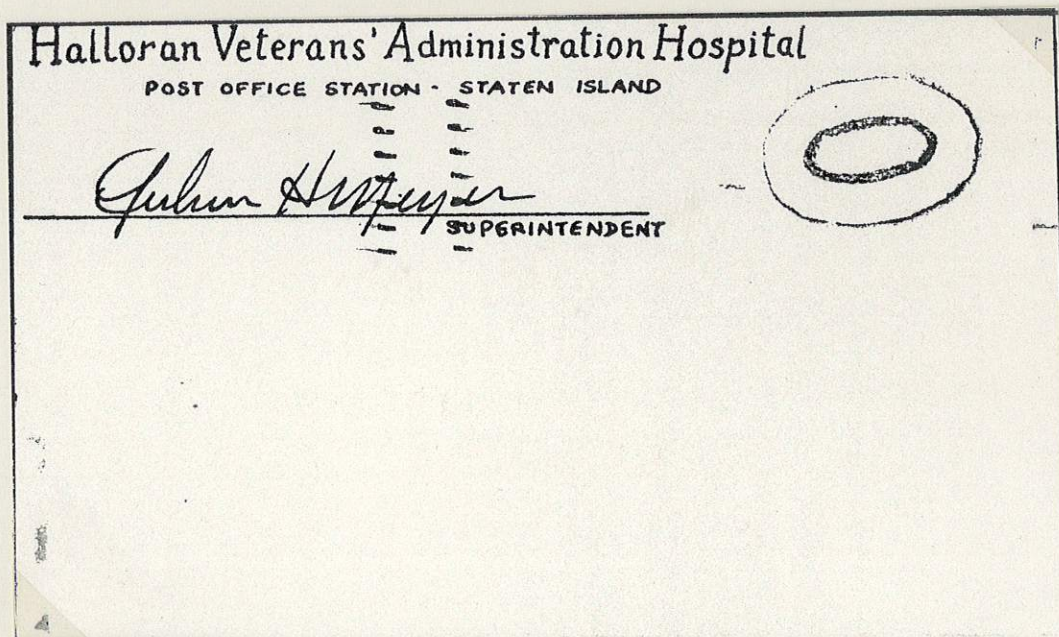


# HALLORAN VETERAN'S ADMINISTRATION HOSPITAL STATION

## BAYLEY SEATON HOSPITAL

The hospital we today call Bayley Seaton was originally the Seaman's Fund and Retreat Hospital. As long ago as 1798 foreign sailors entering New York port had to pay a fee. The accumulation of these fees became a fund in the State treasury known as the Seaman's Retreat and Hospital Fund. In 1831 a law directed that such fees be paid to the trustees of the Seaman's Fund and Retreat. On October first of that year a building, with Peter S. Townsend as he first resident physician, opened on Staten Island. On July 4, 1834 the corner stone, of a new building of the Seaman's Fund and Retreat Hospital, was laid by Samuel Swartwout, President of the Trust. From this time the hospital was known as Marine Hospital.

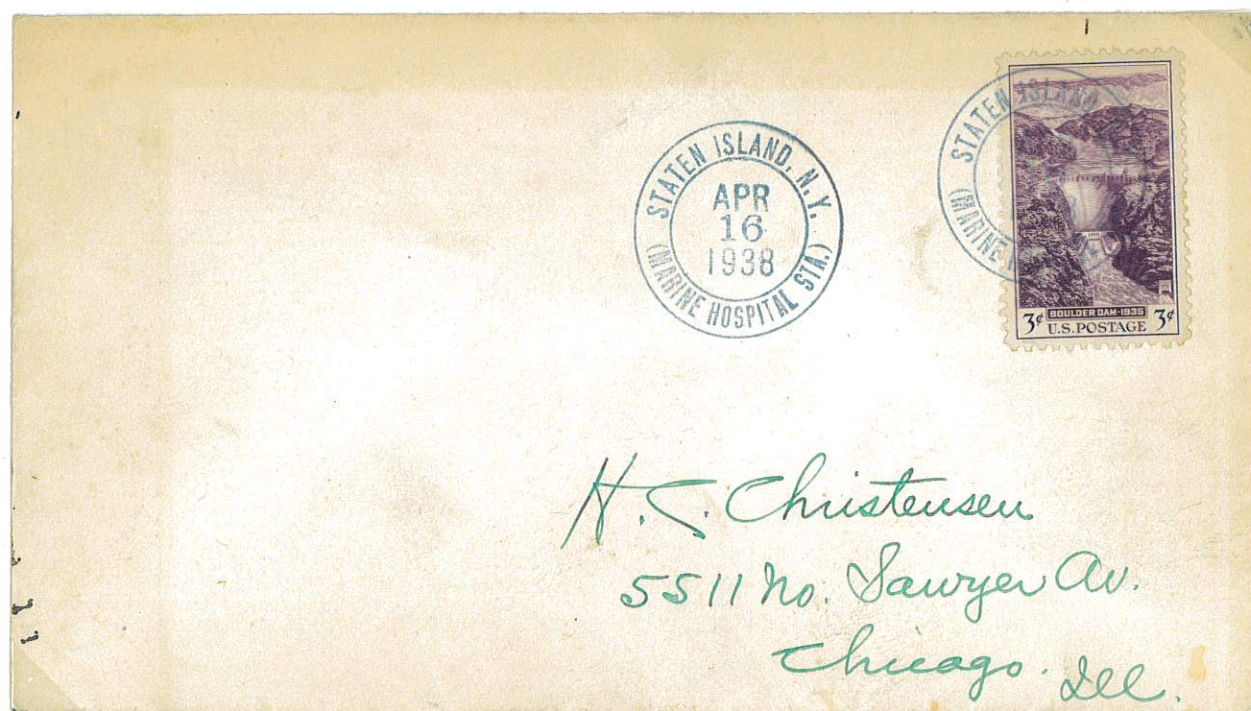
Previous to 1881 the collection of the state head tax was declared unconstitutional and the Retreat was supported by contributions of ship owners. Its support was then assumed by the Marine Society by whom its hospital was rented in 1883 and sold in 1903 to the United States Marine Hospital, No. 21, (information from Leng/Davis "Staten Island and Its People")

A post office station was opened in 1938. In general mail was carried to and from the hospital in sacks and outgoing mail was cancelled at the general post office.

Miller Field as such came into being in 1918 with the purchase by the United States of the Vanderbilt farm at New Dorp. It was named in honor of James Ely Miller, the first American aviator to be killed in combat in France. He was a graduate of Yale, and a banker in New York, who joined the service May 5, 1917 and was killed in battle over the lines at Javincourt on March 9, 1918. In the old Vanderbilt home now lives the Military commandant of the operations in this field dedicated to Captain Miller's memory where daily aeroplanes and hydroplanes are seen.

The Vanderbilt farm was purchased by the government for an aviation field. Staten Island, Dorothy Valentine Smith, page 218.9.

Miller Field at New Dorp was named for the first aviator with an American unit killed in France during World War I. Acquired by the Army in 1919 and used over half a century as an air coast defense station, a testing place for Admiral Byrd's plane used in Antarctica, for Civil Air Patrol, and Green Beret Units, National Guard Aviation and other purposes, Miller Field is now (1970) the target of all kinds of proposals. The mid-air collision between a United Airlines DC-8 and a TWA Constellation on December 16, 1960 occurred over Miller Field.

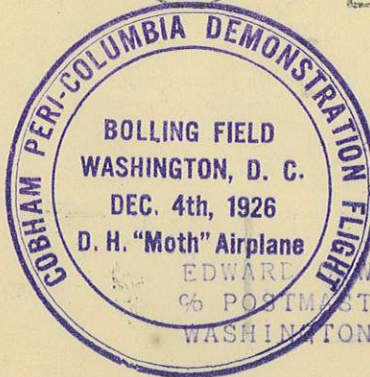

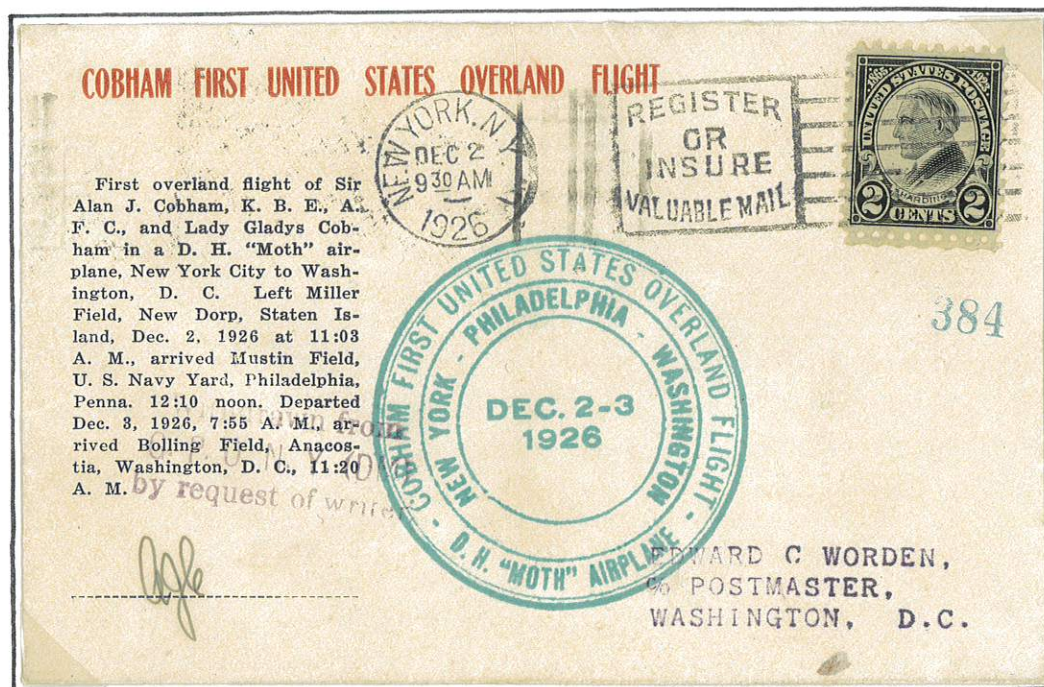

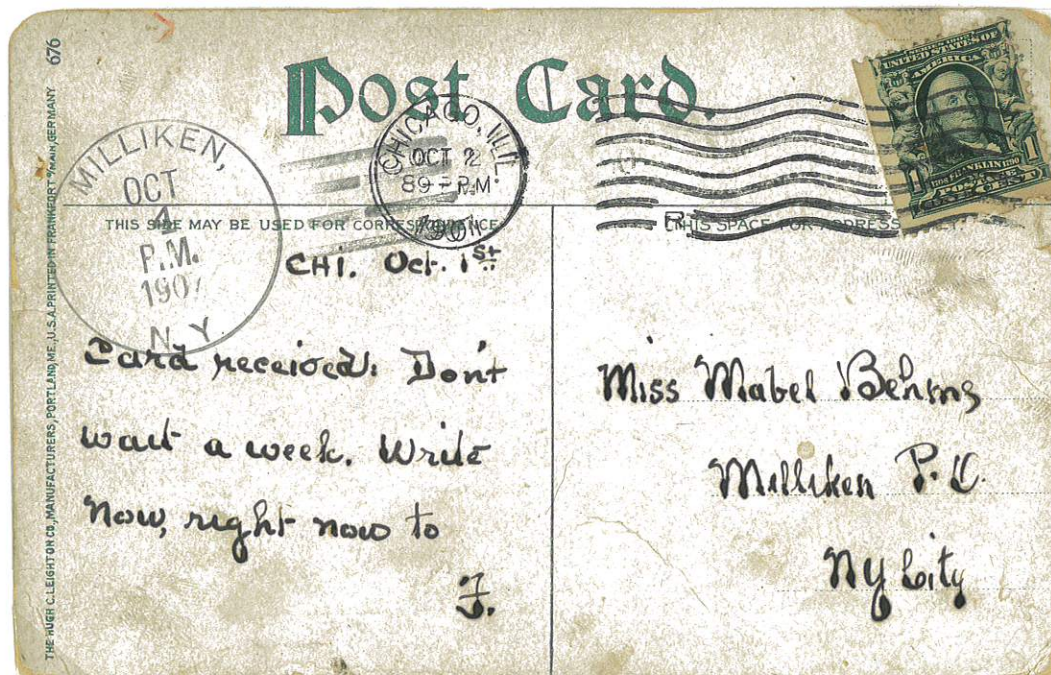

Milliken Brothers' Structural Iron Works and Rolling Mill, originally founded in 1857, erected a large plant near the Elizabeth Ferry, Holland Hook in 1903. The Staten Island factory was one of the world's largest manufacturers of steel products. After the steel trusts were formed, Milliken Brothers dissolved in 1917. The plant was converted into Downey's Shipyard which had large government contracts during World War I. In 1927 this property was the site of the Bellanca Aero-plane Corporation.

The post office which was situated on the water side of the Shore Road now Richmond Terrace was no doubt named after the Milliken Brothers' Plant.

**SESQUICENTENIAL FAIR**

In celebration of the 150th anniversary of the first National Peace Conference which held in the Conference House (Billog House) at Tottenville on September 3, 1776 Staten Island held a Sesquicentennial Celebration from September 3,-11,1926.

A letter from the Sesquicentennial Commission of Staten Island to the Mayor of Philadelphia where the Sesquicentennial International Exposition was being held was carried by Boy Scouts of Staten Island and New Jersey along what had been the Revolutionary post road. Unfortunately no mail other than the hand carried message was officially connected with this event. However, it appears that a Sesquicentennial Fair may have taken place prior to the official event. Probably at Miller Field because the cover which is illustrated below appears to have participated in the fair and was part of the souvenir mail carried.

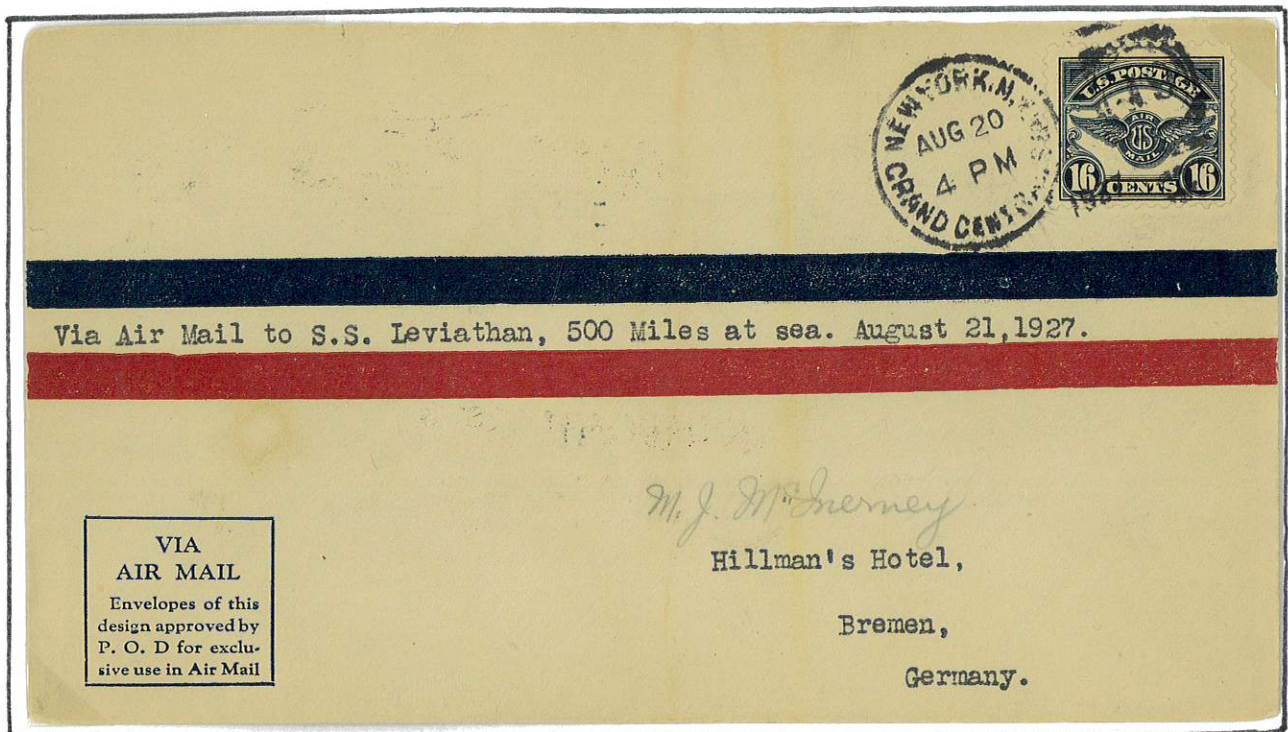
It should be noted that air planes were known to have operated on Staten Island from as early as 1907. However, this is the earliest known example of mail carried by air that we have found.

OLD FRESH KILLS BRIDGE. Also known as Plank Road Bridge, Draw Bridge (Walling, 1859), Garretson's Bridge and Long Bridge

. In December, 1856, an advertisement appeared in the Staten Islander, stating that, "the bridge and causeway over the Fresh Kills Creek and Meadow from the Fresh Kills to De Puy's Corner at Springville" would be sold at public auction on the 20th of the month. in the issue of December 31st, 1856, under the heading of "The Bridge" appears the following: "The Pt Richmond and Fresh Kills Plank Road Bridge, which was recently offered to the county for \$2,000, has been sold at auction to Jacob Garretson, for six hundred and one dollars." Mr Jacob C. Garretson subsequently offered (Staten Islander, January 3d, 1856) to place the bridge and causeways leading thereto in good condition, provided that the towns of Northfield and Westfield would each pay \$633.33. (See Church Road and Garretson's Road) The county has recently had a new bridge built on the site of the old one. It is certain that a great deal more information exists that relates to the roads, bridges and ferries over which early mail on Staten Island was carried either by post riders or on the many stage companies that operated here. However we believe that the information provided will give a good general idea of these facilities.

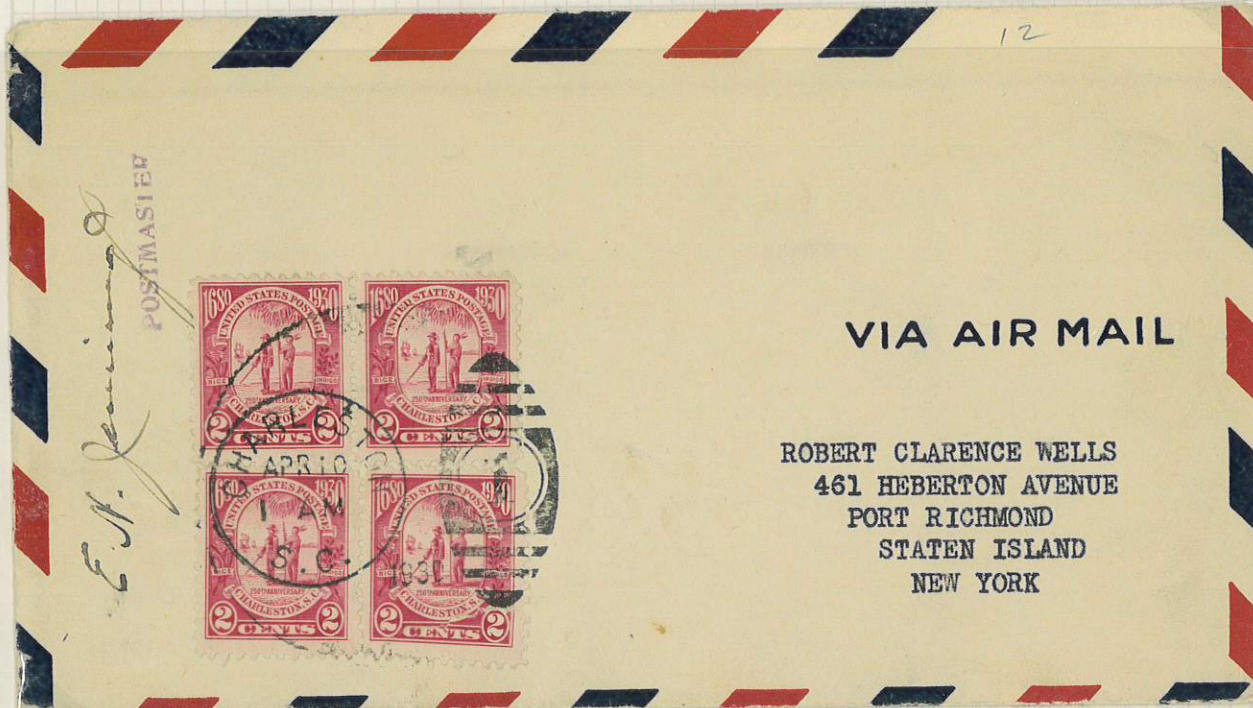


ADVERTISING COVER FROM NEW YORK CITY TO PORT RICHMOND



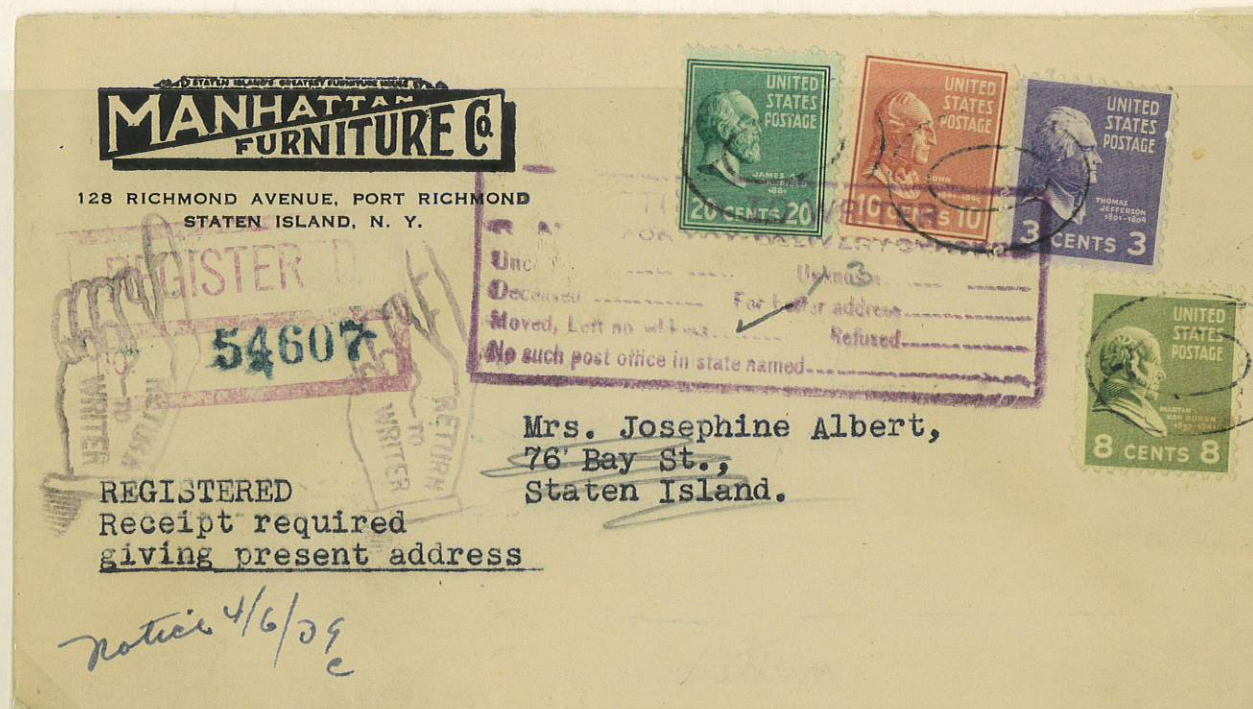

As far as we can determine, Prince's Bay was the name intended for this area of Staten Island and when the name of the post office was changed from Lemon Creek on April 17, 1860, it became Prince's Bay. Local use included Princebay, Prince's Bay, Prince Bay, Princes Bay and Princess Bay and the post office in an attempt to accommodate local use, changed the name several times.

This cover from Purling, N. Y. on May 13, 1910 is addressed to Peter Polworth, Princess Bay, Staten Island, N.Y. The received mark shows Princebay while the post office at this time was Prince Bay.

On the 26th of July, 1861 the Secretary of War authorized Col. Othniel DeForest, of New York City, to raise a regiment of cavalry. By the last of Sept. there had been gathered on Staten Island the nucleus of a fine cavalry brigade. From this assemblage of recruits was organized the Fifth New

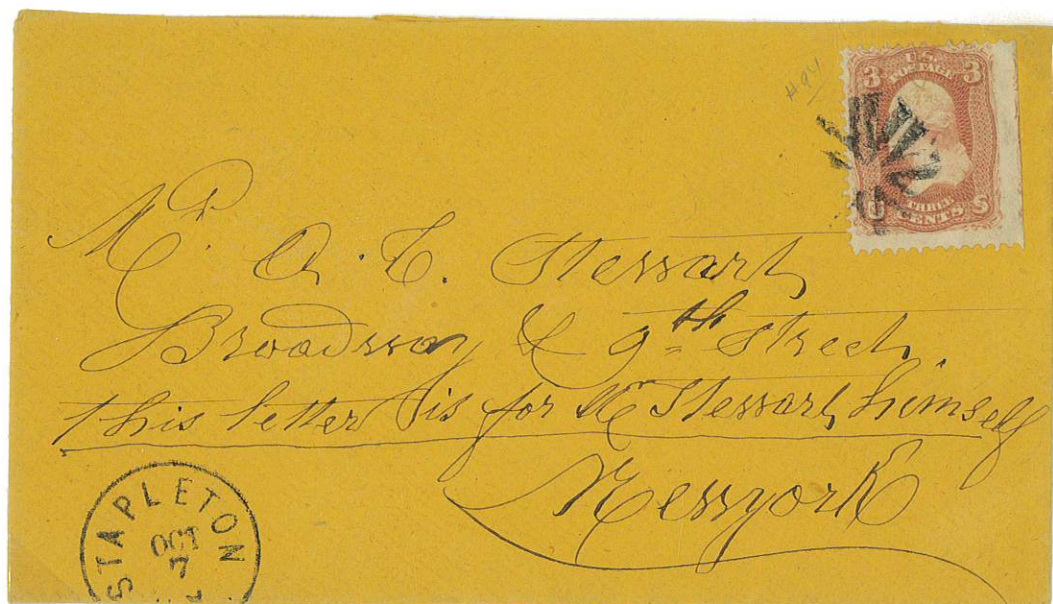
Harris Guards in honor of Senator Ira Harris of Albany. New York City had contributed liberally of men, though whole companies were raised in Essex, Wyoming, Alleghany, and Tioga counties. A few men were obtained from the States of Massachusetts, Connecticut, and New Jersey. No bounties were paid to recruits; but a bounty of \$100 was promised to be paid by the United States at the expiration of service. This multi-colored cover has the Guards corner card and is addressed to a cavalryman's wife, Mrs. Angeline Gorton. A cover similiar to this can be found in The George Walcott Collection of Civil War Patriotic Covers under item # 1217. It has a Scotts Catalog 65 stamp and a circular date stamp from Stapleton, New York.

A Sikorsky helicopter that cost \$48,500 and could cruise at 75 M.P.H. took off from the snow covered athletic field at Wagner College on the first helicopter mail service from Staten Island. The helicopter stopped at Perth Amboy, New Brunswick and Summit before landing at Newark. En route to Staten Island it had landed at Elizabeth and Bayonne.

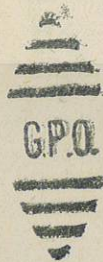
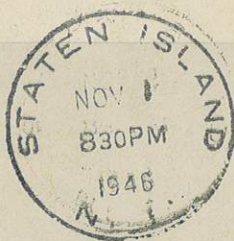
Dear Aunt Betty and Uncle Ray,

# The British Arrive at Staten Island



Colorano "Silk" Cachet



July 2, 1776 — Frustrated in the South, the British now took aim at the Middle States, intending to seize the Hudson Valley and cut the Colonies in two. On June 10th General Howe's fleet left Halifax dropping anchor in lower New York Bay on July 2nd. Three days later the total force of some 9,000 troops, under the command of Generals Howe, Pigot, Grant and Jones, landed unopposed. The Americans braced for action but the British only established camp on Staten Island.
