


# World War 2 Airmail

Iran to United States 1944

Cover from the Persian Corridor in Iran to Attoona, Pennsylvania, despatched 4<sup>th</sup> August 1944. Carried by US Air Transport Command via Cairo to either Casablanca or West Africa then to America. From A.P.O. 523 located at Teheran from 26<sup>th</sup> December 1942. Double concession fee paid but an additional fee charged on arrival, presumably because of re-weighing.

Rate paid: Double 6c concession rate plus 6c due on arrival.




## World War 2 Airmail

Iran to United States 1944

Cover from the Persian Corridor in Iran to Maryland despatched 27<sup>th</sup> July 1944. Carried by US Air Transport Command via Cairo to West Africa and onwards to America. From A.P.O. 784 located at Hamadan in Iran. Writer is serving with one of the transport companies responsible for keeping up the flow of arms and supplies from the Persian Gulf ports up to Baku and into Russia.

Rate paid: 6 cents concession rate.



# World War 2 Airmail

Iran to United States 1943

Cover from the Persian Corridor in Iran to New York despatched 18<sup>th</sup> December 1943. Carried by US Air Transport Command via Cairo to West Africa and onwards to America. From A.P.O. 797 located at Andimeshk in Iran. Letter describes how the writer has been training drivers on the diesel trucks used to carry strategic war supplies on the Khorramshar – Teheran – Baku route into Russia.

Rate paid: 6 cents concession rate.






Dec 16, 1943.




## World War 2 Airmail

Cover from the Persian Corridor in Iran to Washington despatched 5<sup>th</sup> March 1944. Carried by US Air Transport Command via Cairo to West Africa and onwards to America. From A.P.O. 784 located at Hamadan in Iran. Writer is serving with one of the transport companies responsible for keeping up the flow of arms and supplies from the Persian Gulf ports up to Baku and into Russia.

Rate paid: 6 cents concession rate.



## World War 2 Airmail

### Iran to United States 1943

Cover from Teheran to New York despatched 23<sup>rd</sup> September 1943. Carried by BOAC to Lagos then by PanAm FAM22 to Miami and New York. Opened and re-sealed by censor in Iran and again in New York. Soviet-Persian dual language censor cachet No. 25.

Rate paid: 12R 10ch.
