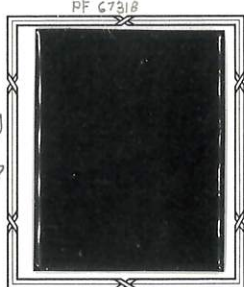
Denomination in Oval

Postage Due Stamps were authorized by the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1879, effective July 1, 1879. The first set consisted of seven different denominations released between May 9, 1879 and September 19, 1879 on unwatermarked paper.

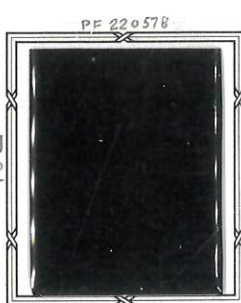
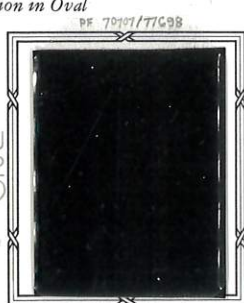
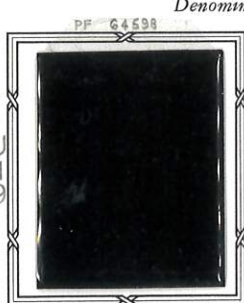

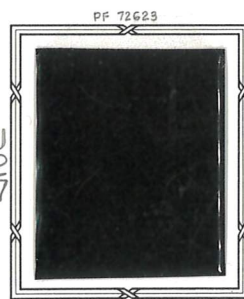
During 1891 to 1893, colors were again changed from red brown to bright claret. Some imperforate varieties exist, but they were not regularly issued.



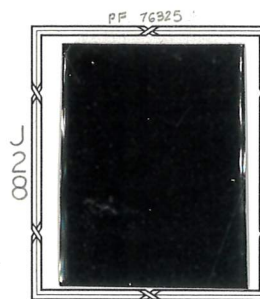

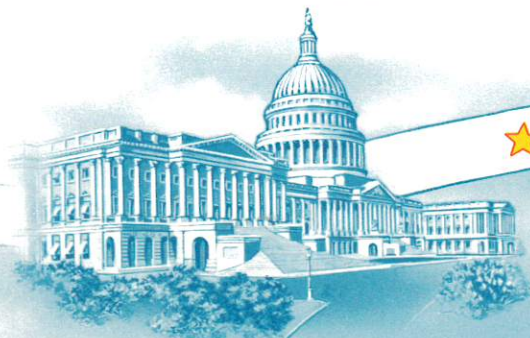

Denomination over Pattern Background



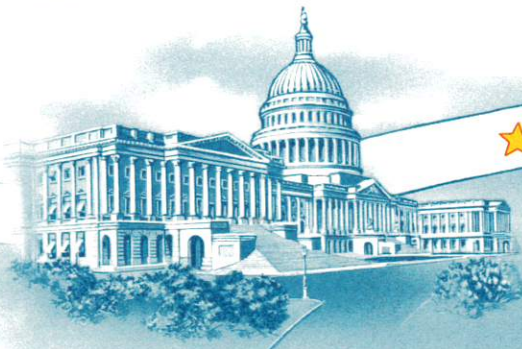
A completely new design was introduced in 1894 when the Bureau of Engraving and Printing took over production of postage stamps from the Post Office Note Companies.
