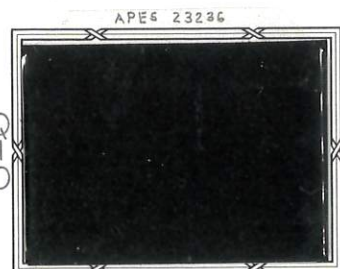

Under the provisions of the act of Congress approved August 24, 1912, the Department prepared a set of twelve parcel post stamps and five parcel post-postage due stamps of distinctive designs. The designs were prepared in 3 groups of 4 stamps each, the working personnel of the Postal Service being represented by the first group, the transportation of the mail by the second group, and the manufacturing and agricultural interests of the country by the third group. The stamps were first placed on sale January 1, 1913 with the inauguration of the parcel post law.
