
200 – Subject printing plates for the Jamestown stamps were printed on the four-plank steam press. Four plates were on press for each printing. Each plate produced plate numbers on the top and bottom of a sheet. A total of nine 1¢ plates, thirty 2¢ plates, and four 5¢ plates went to press from April 12, 1907 through Oct 3, 1907. Additionally, three 1¢ and four 2¢ plates were made, but were not used.
