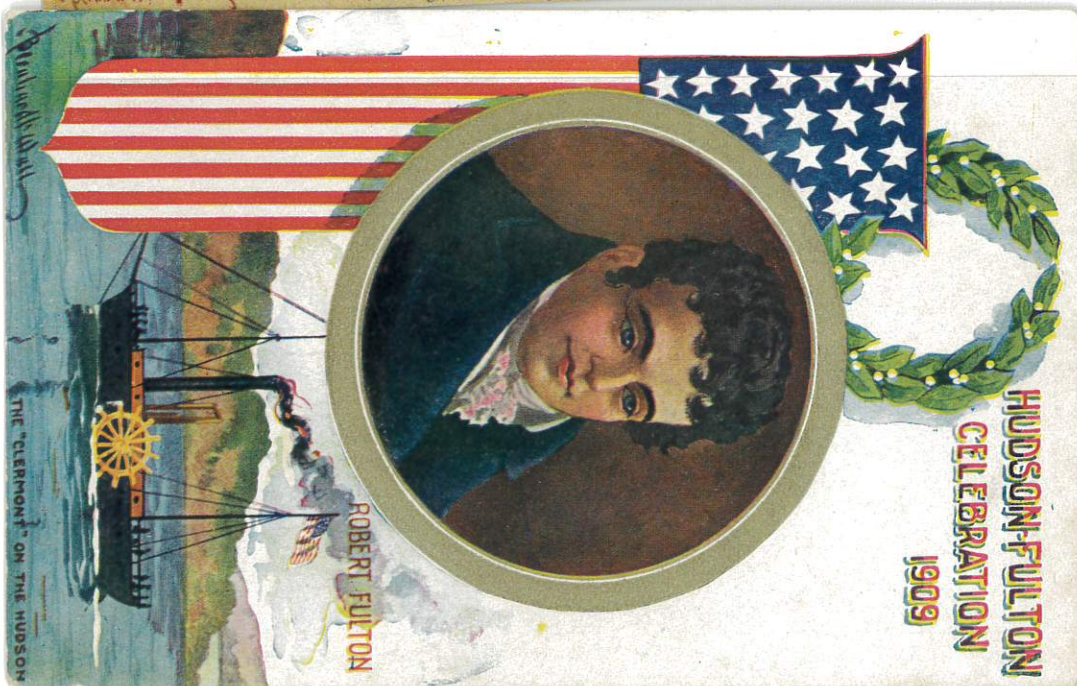


FLOAT — TITLE CAR: COLONIAL PERIOD

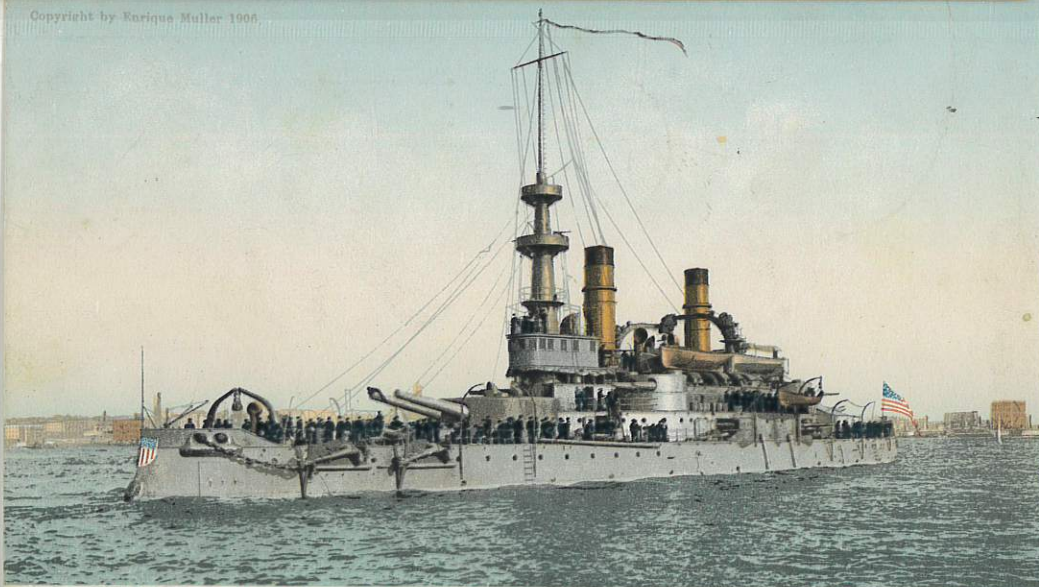
