Some covers are signed by one or both pilots, with typewritten inscription "Carried on the New York to Rome flight, Cesare Sabelli and Capt. George R. Pond, Bellanca NR-13137." Covers bear a number of cancellations including the following: New York, Oct. 10, 1933, Brooklyn, N.Y., Oct. 17, 1933, Brooklyn, N.Y., Jan. 5, 1934, New York or Brooklyn, N.Y., May 13, 1934, and are backstamped Leact Uj Concubair, May 15, 1934, and/or Rome, June 11, 1934. Some of the covers were carried all the way to Rome and have backstamp at Rome, June 11, 1934; others were mailed back to the U.S.A. from England and have an additional English stamp cancelled London June 7, 1934. Most covers are signed by one or both of the pilots.

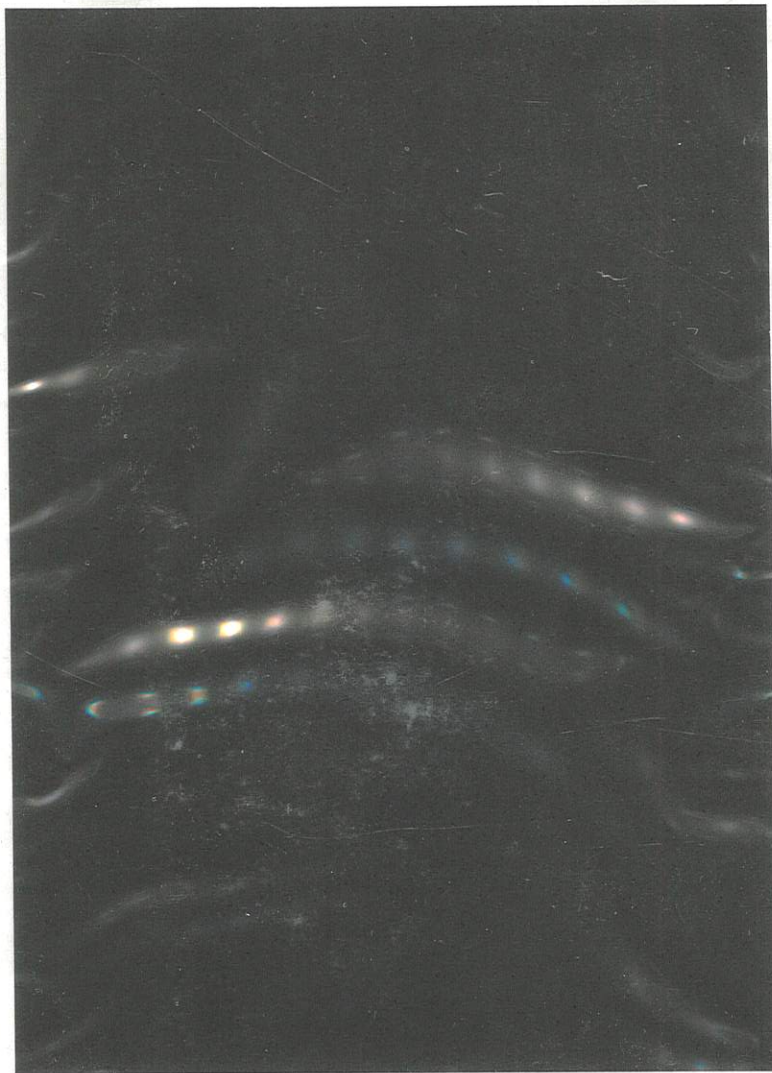

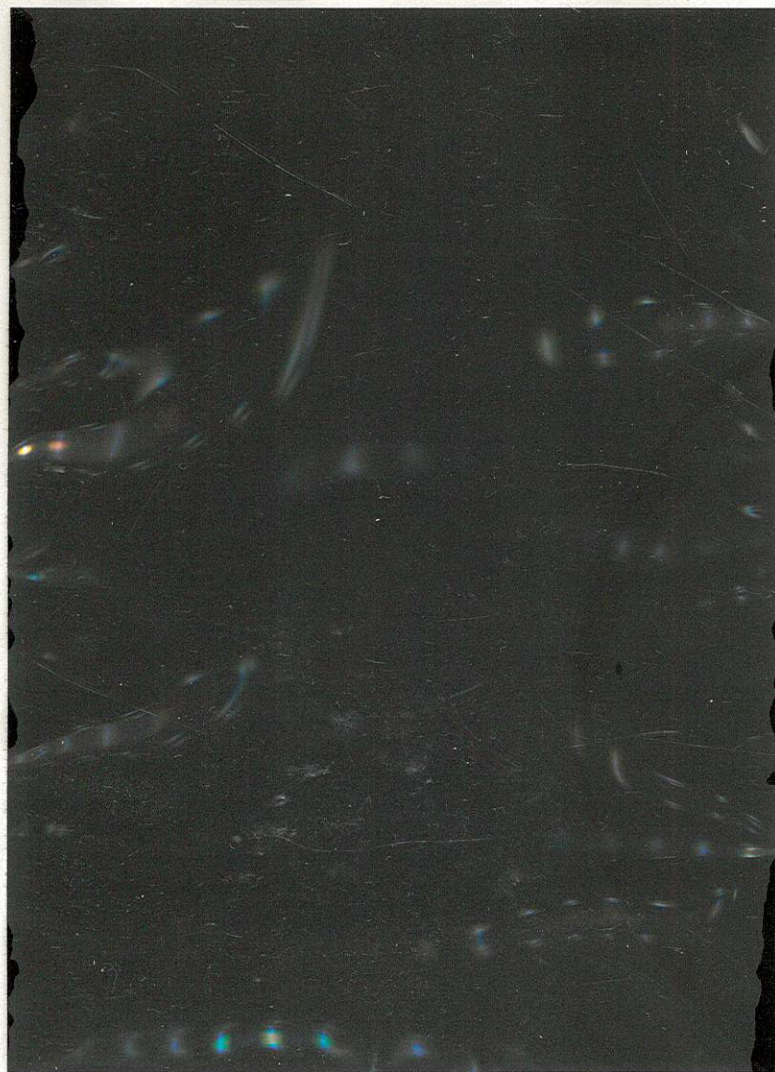
